#### **Day1: Luxor East Bank Tours**

After our representative picks you up from your Luxor hotel, you will begin your 5-day Nile Cruise Tour from Luxor to Aswan. Your tour guide will give you the keys to your cabin, and after a brief break, you can savor your first lunch on board the MS Royal Viking Nile Cruise.

Luxor is located 700 kilometers south of Cairo. Your English-speaking Egyptologist guide will meet you in the lobby to start your <u>Luxor East Bank Tours</u>. After that, carry on with your Luxor explorations as you are taken to the magnificent Luxor Temple, which was founded in 1884 on the <u>East Bank of the Nile in Luxor</u>. The temple is situated in the city that bears his name. Spend the night on board after Luxor tours to continue your program.

You also can have an optional **Sound and Light Show** in Karnak Temple

## **Day 2: Continue visiting Luxor West Bank Tours**

You will meet your tour guide to start your West Bank tour of Luxor after enjoying your delectable breakfast aboard the MS Royal Viking Nile Cruise. Here, you will see the magnificent rock-cut tombs of the New Kingdom pharaohs, also known as the Valley of the Kings, where they built their tombs very far away from the tomb thieves. To date, more than 60 tombs carved into the rocks have been discovered. Additionally, proceed with <u>Luxor West Bank Tours</u> to see <u>the Colossi of Memnon</u>, the enormous statues of Queen Hatshepsut that stand thirty meters (nine stories) tall, and the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u>, also known as the <u>Temple of El Deir El Bahari</u>. and the great King Amenhotep III will be your last Luxor day tours. Your tasty lunch will be served aboard the <u>Luxor to Aswan Nile Cruise</u> and then you will enjoy sailing to Edfu.

Optional: <u>Luxor Hot Air Balloon Ride</u> above the west bank monuments.

In the evening your delightful dinner will be served and you will stay overnight aboard the Nile Cruise in Edfu

## Day 3: Discovering Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

After spending the previous two days on Luxor sightseeing tours, you will now enjoy a delicious breakfast on board the Nile Cruise. You will also be joined by your knowledgeable tour guide for one of the most fascinating <a href="Egypt day tours">Egypt day tours</a>, which takes you to <a href="Edfu">Edfu</a> to visit the <a href="Temple of Horus">Temple of Horus</a>, which is one of the largest and best-preserved <a href="Egyptian temples">Egyptian temples</a>, having retained all of its original features. Afterward, you will return to the cruise ship and enjoy a charming sail southward until you reach Kom Ombo, where you will have a unique lunch on board.

Once you reach Kom Ombo, you will be taken to see the amazing Kom Ombo Temple, which honors the crocodile god Sobek. Built between 1350 and 180 B.C. on King Ramses II's orders, the temple is

dedicated to the crocodile god. After your <u>tour of Kom Ombo and Edfu</u> is over, enjoy a delicious dinner on board the cruise, local music, entertainment, and an overnight stay in the stunning city of Aswan.

### **Day 4: Fantastic Aswan Nile Cruise Tours**

Breakfast will be served to you on your Egypt Nile cruise as you begin your day. Then, prepare to meet your personal tour guide and start your Aswan excursions as follows:

#### The High dam:

See the <u>High Dam</u>, which protected Egypt from the Nile floods that would have otherwise drowned the country and left months' worth of water unutilized. Egypt's southernmost city is Aswan. It is situated nearly a thousand kilometers from Cairo in the first Nile waterfall.

#### The Unfinished Obelisk:

In the granite quarries where the ancient Egyptians once extracted and transported granite to build the great pyramids of Egypt's history, as well as the enormous temples, pillars, and obelisks, particularly during the new kingdom.

#### Temple Philae:

Continue with your Aswan tours to the Greco-Roman-style <u>Philae temple</u>, one of the four locations where the legend of Isis, Osiris, and Horus occurred. The temple was constructed with the worship of Goddess Isis in mind.

After being transferred back to the cruise ship, you will eat lunch, have a free afternoon in Aswan, and then enjoy a delicious dinner prepared and served on the cruise ship. In the evening, you will watch a fascinating Nubian show and spend the night in Aswan.
