<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Cairo - Bahariya Oasis - White Desert

Early in the morning, your pick-up will be from your hotel in Cairo or Giza in a comfortable air-conditioned car. You will be assisted by your professional tour guide to <u>Baharya Oasis</u>. There is a nice green surrounding area as well prior to heading out to the historic wasteland where an oasis is close to the region.

The first Interesting Site is known as the <u>Valley of Golden Mummies</u> where two Ultimate mummies do that exquisite burial job. From here one can enjoy being free extent within the boundaries of the Tombs of the Noble and the name well suits the rank of upper ancient Bahariya social class. Out of all these cemeteries, the tombs of Zed-Amun-Ef-Ankh and Bannentiu tombs are famous because these tombs are characterized by a 'layering' or sequel of funerary inserts which indicates how diverse cultures intermingled in these regions.

The next stop is the temple of Alexander the Great which is said in local legend she [Biblioteka] was asleep on her way to the Siwa oasis. During the first scientific campaigns, the temple of Ain El-Mefetla was believed to belong to the period of the <u>26th dynasty</u>. However additional evidence has shown that this temple contains five chapels which were crucial in the study of this cult statue.

Day 2: Back to Cairo

The first meal of the day takes on a unique experience of a bedouin breakfast: The tea boiled is served in the morning. Stretching with the boastful dawn. The first promising activity for people would be a bath in hot springs as the water purges all the physical and mental strains and realistic people appreciate that they are in an oasis.

Now the <u>white Desert</u> of Egypt, known for rabbit ears resembling rocks and mushrooms cliff formations smoothened over the ages. The rather interesting aspect of this place is that it is surrounded by many other places which are interesting photo-shooting sites and even playgrounds of nature.

But even before Cairo, the small oasis of Bahariya is found which is an oasis in the middle of the desert and a green island in a sea of dunes. on the way, you can also visit the <u>Black Desert</u> which is almost on every side of the roads fully covered with small black volcanic stones hence the name. You will also be able to visit some other parts like the saltwater ui. lavatories and Worksheets about the sands of the region and the story about the area from the Bedouin guide and the other attractions.
