Itinerary

Day 1: Cairo - Alamein - Siwa

Your Cairo Top Tours professional tour leader will meet you at your hotel and embark on your Egypt Desert Safari to Siwa Oasis. It begins with the El Alamein tour where you will visit the World War II Cemeteries: this will be the going in honor of the fighters who struggled as well as offering their lives. These cemeteries are owned by the Commonwealth War Graves Commission to pay respect to those who from common-wealth nations participated in the war. You will also pay a visit to the ground zero where the fateful battle was fought and also tour through the World War II Museum at El Alamein.

There are more places to visit after that, namely the beautiful <u>Marsa Matrouh</u> Bay on the North Coast of Egypt. There, you will enjoy a tasty seafood lunch facing the clear sea, followed by an hour's drive to Siwa from El Alamein.

Upon arriving in Siwa, you'll have an opportunity to put your feet in the hot water springs – natural sources of water at your disposal after a rather tiring day of traveling. Spend your last night at a lovely Eco-lodge in the village of <u>Siwa</u>, the perfect way to get a true sense of the night in the desert.

Day 2: Siwa Sightseeing

The day is again devoted to the desert and the Siwa Oasis Desert Safari; after breakfast, you explore the ruins of the ancient town of Siwa, or Shali. Siwa is a comparatively young settlement; therefore, some partial remains of the ancient town allow an understanding of the history of the place. Subsequently, you will be taken to the Temple of Alexander the Great – it is called the <u>Temple of the Oracle</u> in the ancient village of Aghurmi. Built during the 26th dynasty, this temple still served an important function during the age and was said to be the place where <u>Alexander the Great</u> consulted with oracles.

You are then taken for a tour at the <u>Temple of Amun Ra</u> at Um Ubeyda which is believed to be a deity temple for god Amun and his triad. Later on, get to taste Siwa's historical side by being able to walk through the house of the Siwa museum which gives a detailed account of the Bedouin people.

Savor a nice meal with the outstanding Equipment Restaurant in the square of the oasis with the Shali fortress view.

In the afternoon visit <u>Cleopatra's Spring</u> (Ein Guba) which is basically a natural source of fresh water that is very clear for swimming. You complete your day mic with a beautiful sunset view at Fitnas Island with eye satisfaction as you gaze at the sunset sets complete the sand desert.

Overnight in Siwa.

Day 3: Shiata - Great Sand Sea - Bir Wahed

Break up the best organic meal at the eco-lodge for breakfast to kick-start the energy for the day's activities. This call takes your <u>Great Sand Sea</u> road trip to Maraki village where you will tour a unique archaeological site at the towering Siwa Mountain. Here you can witness the first human footprint ever made giving your desert safari a rich history.

Next, you'll visit one of the most stunning sights in the Great Sand Sea: this is a beautiful lake in the middle of the desert. The calm nature of the area provides an ideal environment for a bird-watching exercise and occasionally you can view a flock of flamingos. Tire your body and go for a swim in the cold and crystal clear water enjoying the solitude in the middle of the desert.

For those who love tasty moments, the movement is only continued by an interesting view of sandboarding. Sail over the extensive sand hills of the Great Sand Sea; with an appropriate wax effort, have fun sliding over the fine sand. Subsequently, such tourists may take a break and free time to wash off the dust of the desert by bathing at one of the famous Hot Springs <u>Bir Wahid</u>. Their water was 40°C which gives one a nice pleasant feeling as muscles are eased.

Overnight in Siwa.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 4: Siwa Oasis

Breakfast is served at the eco-lodge with tasty meals that you need for the day which will be used in exploring more. This Siwa Oasis tour starts with the exploration of the rock-cut tombs found in the Mountain of the Dead referred to as Gabal El Mawta. Here you can investigate the very interesting tombs of <u>26th Dynasty</u> of Siwa rulers, like the Tomb of Si Amon and the Crocodile Tomb.

After that, you will go to the Bedouin village of Abu Ali to try the locally known Bedouin way of life which may be very interesting. It is also important to use the opportunity and visit their one-class school and investigate other aspects of their everyday life. During this cultural experience, you'll see the Tomb of Alexander the Great—a place that completes the cultural experience of the tour.

Later in the morning, head back to Siwa to explore <u>Dakrour Mountain</u> which is very significant to the cultural values of the Siwan community. Attached to the above festival, the people of El Syaha organize the Tourism Festival of El Syaha on the first full moon of October every year. The Siwan community holds the festival dear and It will be an opportunity to understand its importance while the feast to the eyes in that mountainous region.

After in the evening, you will proceed back to your hotel for dinner and overnight at Siwa.

Day 5: Final Departure

After breakfast, we drive back to Cairo with our Egyptologist guide and we trust you enjoyed your trip through Siwa Oasis Desert Safari from Cairo.
