<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Have a great day in Aswan

Your journey commences with a certified tour guide meeting you at your hotel in Aswan, or <u>Aswan Airport</u>, or the railway station. You will then venture on a 4-day Nile River Cruise from Aswan to Luxor aboard a 5-star Egypt Nile River Cruise, starting with an open-buffet lunch upon boarding. After lunch, your exploration of Aswan begins with a visit to the <u>High Dam</u>, a noteworthy engineering feat crucial to Egypt's modern history, providing flood control and substantial power since its completion.

Continuing the Aswan excursions, you will visit the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, believed to have been commissioned by <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> during the New Kingdom, located in the red granite quarries. Following this, a motorboat ride will take you to the captivating <u>Philae Temple</u> on Agilika Island, an ancient site steeped in the myth of Isis and Osiris. After concluding the Aswan tours, return to the Nile cruise boat for dinner and an overnight stay in Aswan.

Meals provided include lunch and dinner.

Day 2: sail for Edfu and explore the Kom-Ombo Temple

After enjoying a pleasurable breakfast aboard the voyage boat, passengers will have the option to share in a fresh tour of <u>Abu Simbel</u>. Following lunch, the Nile voyage will depart for Kom Ombo. Upon appearance, passengers will visit the <u>Kom Ombo Temple</u>, which is historically notable for its association with the training of African mammoths for military purposes. This tabernacle venerates the crocodile <u>god Sobek</u> and Haroeris, a form of the god Horus. Meals gave Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

Day 3: Exploration Tour to Edfu Temple

Commence your day with a delightful breakfast aboard the MS Nile Radamis Nile River Cruise. Following breakfast, embark on a horse-drawn carriage ride through <u>Edfu</u> town to visit the <u>Temple of Horus</u>. After the tour, lunch will be served on the boat. Enjoy afternoon tea as the vessel continues its journey towards Luxor. Upon arrival, accommodations for the night will be in Luxor.

In the evening, guests have the option to join an additional excursion to the <u>sound and light show</u> at Karnak Temple.

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

Day 4: Bye Bye From Luxor

On the final day of the tour, the day begins with a satisfying breakfast aboard the cruise ship before

checking out. Thereafter, the participants will embark on a comprehensive Luxor day tour led by a professional guide, covering both the <u>East and West Banks</u> of the Nile River. The exploration commences at the <u>Karnak Temples</u>, a complex of ancient Egyptian temples constructed over centuries by various pharaohs from 2200 to 360 B.C. Following this, the group will visit the <u>Luxor Temple</u>, a significant holy site built between 1400 and 1000 B.C. under the rules of Pharaohs <u>Amenhotep III</u> and <u>Ramses II</u>.

The tour then continues on the <u>West Bank</u>, where the group will explore the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, a recognized site for its numerous royal tombs. Anciently named "Ta Iset Maat," translating to "place of truth," this site holds enormous historical significance. The participants will also visit the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u>, an architectural marvel dedicated to the pharaoh Hatshepsut, the only woman to rule Egypt extensively. Additionally, the group will view the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, a pair of massive stone statues defining Pharaoh Amenhotep III. After completing the comprehensive tour, the participants will be transferred to their desired location in Luxor.

As an optional activity, the participants may choose to join an early morning excursion for <u>a hot air balloon ride</u> over Luxor, providing a unique and breathtaking perspective of the ancient city and its surroundings.

Throughout the day, the participants will be provided with meals, including breakfast, lunch, and dinner, ensuring a well-rounded and enjoyable experience.
