<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Hey from Aswan

The journey begins with a certified tour guide meeting the participants at their hotel in Aswan, the <u>Aswan Airport</u>, or the railway station. From there, the participants embark on a 4-day Nile River Cruise from Aswan to Luxor aboard a 5-star Egypt Nile River Cruise. Upon boarding, they enjoy an open-buffet lunch.

Afterward, the exploration of Aswan commences with a visit to the <u>High Dam</u>, an iconic engineering feat crucial to Egypt's modern history, providing flood control and significant power since its completion. Continuing the Aswan excursions, the participants visit the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, believed to have been commissioned by <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> during the New Kingdom, located in the red granite quarries. Following this, a motorboat ride takes them to the breathtaking <u>Philae Temple</u> on Agilika Island, an ancient site central to the myth of Isis and Osiris. After concluding the Aswan tours, the participants return to the Nile cruise boat for dinner and an overnight stay in Aswan.

The meals provided on this day include lunch and dinner, setting the stage for the immersive and indulgent Nile River Cruise experience.

Day 2: Visit Edfu and the Kom-Ombo Temple

After a satisfying breakfast on the cruise ship, the participants have the opportunity to opt for an additional tour to Abu Simbel. Following lunch, the Nile cruise sets sail for Kom Ombo.

Upon arrival at Kom Ombo, the visitors will explore the <u>Kom Ombo Temple</u>, renowned historically for its association with the training of African elephants for military purposes. This temple venerates <u>Sobek</u>, the crocodile god, and Haroeris, a variant of Horus. The day concludes with the ship journeying to Edfu, where dinner will be served on board, and the guests will spend the night.

Additionally, they observe the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>. Upon concluding the tour, the participants are transferred to their preferred location in Luxor.

In the early morning, the participants have the option to join an excursion for <u>a hot air balloon ride</u> over Luxor, providing a unique and breathtaking perspective of the region's ancient wonders.
