Itinerary

Day 1: Welcome to Cairo City

After you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> You will be met by a representative on your arrival from this point; your Tour Leader will meet you in a comfortable & fully air-conditioned deluxe vehicle and transfer you over to your hotel.

First and foremost we want your <u>Cairo Stopover tour</u> to be one of the greatest experiences we have ever had. For check-in upon arrival to your hotel if possible, the tour manager will help you with this and also go through your 4-day Cairo itinerary so you know when to pick up. Day 2 : Giza Pyramids - Saqqara - Memphis

Your second day is about an expedition around Cairo's renowned landmarks. The Giza Plateau welcomes you on this tour. Gaze at the Pyramids of Egypt, including the **Great Pyramid of Khufu**, the sole wonder of the ancient world that has survived. Nearby, sit the second-tallest, the **Pyramid of Chephren**, still retaining a part of the original limestone casing at the apex. The legendary Great **Sphinx**, the world's largest monolithic statue, stands guard over the site and is believed to symbolize the power and wisdom of Pharaoh Chephren. Visit the **Valley Temple of Khafra**, where royal embalming rites took place in times past.

Travel to Saqqarah with the <u>Egypt Classic Tour</u> to go to the <u>Step Pyramid</u> of King Djoser, designed by the famous architect Imhotep. This marvel is in fact the world's first stone pyramid, having symbolized a turning point in ancient Egyptian architecture. Vast, Saqqara's necropolis shows the long history of pyramid building.

Conclude the day at <u>Memphis</u>, Egypt's ancient capital, founded by King Menes around 3100 BCE. Once the cultural center of the old Kingdom, Memphis is primarily an open-air museum that exhibits rare relics, including the sculpture of Ramses II and the ivory Sphinx that still shows its past.

Day 3: Khan El khalili - Old and Islamic Cairo

On the third day of your tour, visit the Egyptian museum to explore the beauty of the Egyptian historical culture and pay a visit to the <u>Citadel of Saladin</u>, the pathway to the historic bastion that has been guiding Cairo's fate since it was constructed in the 12th century. It is placed upon one of Egypt's mountain ranges called Mokattam and enables panoramic views of the whole city down below. Here stands the astonishing Muhammad Ali Mosque, also called the Alabaster Mosque, breathtaking with its splendid Ottoman architecture and magnificent domes. Thus, as you walk through this well-fortified citadel, several layers of historical accounts unfold, with Cairo's Islamic heritage bare for you.

This is followed by another trip around the <u>Islamic area of Cairo</u> on your <u>Islamic Cairo tours</u>. The district is filled with historic mosques, madrasas, and medieval streets reflecting Islamic architectural greatness. Engage in enjoying the minute details of the old buildings and experience the cultural richness of one of the most animated neighborhoods of Cairo.

Thereafter, you enter <u>Coptic Cairo</u>—a sanctuary into spirituality and history. You may arrive at the <u>Hanging Church</u>, this mightily patterned church is one of the oldest and most stunning of churches in Egypt, built over the ruins of the Fortress of Roman Babylon.
