Day 1: Cairo - Siwa

The journey starts with a visit to El Alamein, where you will explore the World War II Cemeteries, honoring the men and women of the Commonwealth nations who served during the war. You'll visit the historic battle site and tour the fascinating World War II Museum to gain insight into this pivotal period.

Next, we drive to the picturesque bay of <u>Marsa Matrouh</u> on the North Coast, where you'll enjoy a delightful seafood lunch by the sea. Afterward, continue the journey to Siwa, a scenic six-hour drive from El Alamein. Upon arrival, relax with a refreshing swim in a natural hot spring before being transferred to your eco-lodge for an overnight stay in this tranquil oasis.

Day 2: Siwa Sightseeing

After enjoying a delightful breakfast, you'll set off for an exciting Desert Safari adventure in Siwa Oasis. Your first stop will be the ancient town of Shali, once a thriving settlement, now standing as a remarkable relic in the desert. Parts of it are under reconstruction due to its historical significance. From there, you'll continue to the Temple of the Oracle, also known as <u>Alexander the Great's Temple</u>, located in the ancient village of Aghurmi, dating back to the 26th Dynasty.

Next, you'll visit the <u>Temple of Amun Ra</u> in Um Ubeyda, dedicated to the triad of gods including Amun. You will also explore the Siwa House Museum, where you can learn about the rich culture and traditions of the Bedouin people of Siwa. Enjoy a memorable lunch at one of the most picturesque spots in the oasis, either within the historic Shali Fortress or at the charming Adbo Restaurant.

Afterward, visit <u>Cleopatra's Spring</u>, also known as Ein Guba, where you can take a dip in the crystalclear waters of this natural spring, a popular attraction for travelers seeking a refreshing swim.

On day four, start your morning with a visit to the serene Nars Island and end your day with a spectacular sunset at Fitnas Island. As you relax in the peaceful surroundings of Siwa in the evening, you'll have time to reflect on the incredible experiences of the day.

Day 3: Shiata - Great Sand Sea - Bir Wahed

As you wake up in the morning, enjoy a hearty breakfast at the eco-lodge while looking forward to an

exciting day exploring the vast <u>Great Sand Sea</u>. Your first stop will be Maraki Village, located near the majestic Siwa Mountain. Here, you'll discover fascinating remnants of early human civilization, with seven fossilized coral rocks from the Cambrian age standing as silent witnesses to history amidst the desert landscape.

For thrill-seekers, sandboarding on the towering dunes of the Great Sand Sea awaits. While not as fast-paced as snowboarding, the exhilarating sensation of gliding down the soft golden sands is an adventure of its own. With the right wax, you'll glide effortlessly across the dunes, making the experience even more enjoyable.

After the excitement, unwind with a relaxing dip in the hot spring waters of <u>Bir Wahid</u>, where the soothing 40°C temperature will ease your muscles and rejuvenate your spirit.

As the day winds down, you'll witness a breathtaking sunset over the Great Sand Sea, a magical ending to a day filled with adventure and wonder.

Day 4: Siwa Oasis

Begin your day with breakfast at the eco-lodge before continuing your Siwa Oasis adventure. Next, visit the Bedouin village of Abu Ali, where you'll experience the traditional Bedouin lifestyle. Explore unique aspects of their daily life, such as the one-class school and other cultural landmarks. You'll also have the opportunity to visit the site believed to be the Tomb of Alexander the Great.

Afterward, return to Siwa to visit <u>Dakrour Mountain</u>, where the locals celebrate the annual Tourism Festival of El Syaha during the first full moon of October. This site holds great cultural significance for the Siwi people.

At the end of the day, return to your hotel in Siwa for a restful overnight stay.
