<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Cairo - Bahariya Oasis - White Desert

You will be picked up early morning from your hotel in Cairo or Giza and get transfers in an air-conditioned car to <u>Bahariya Oasis</u> with an experienced Bedouin guide. While approaching the area of the oasis, one is surrounded and close to the beautiful green environment before proceeding to the historical desert.

Your first destination is the interesting place called <u>Valley of the Golden Mummies</u> where ten Royal mummies show us what burial rituals were like. From here you can walk around in the zone of the <u>Tombs of the Nobles</u>, which describes the status of the ancient Bahariya upper class. Among these tombs, the most prominent are the Tomb of Zed-Amun-Ef-Ankh and the Tomb of Bannentiu enlarged over generations to accommodate more burials reflecting the demise of the cultures of the region.

After this, proceeded to the Temple of Alexander the Great which bibliography is credited to have slept during his journey toward Siwa Oasis. The Temple of Ain El-Mefetla belonged to the 26th
29th
Dynasty Incidentally, the more recent archaeological explorations have shown that there are four more chapels in the temple and this went a long way to establishing the importance of this religious center of worship.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 2: Back to Cairo

As the sun rises over the empty desert you start your day with a delightful Bedouin-style breakfast including tea, facing a beautiful horizon you wouldn't dare to disturb. The first activity of interest is a dip into the hot springs, which not only help wash away physical and mental fatigue but also provide a real sense of being at an oasis.

From here go to the extraordinary <u>White Desert</u> of Egypt, which is famous for the mushroom-shaped limestone formations and 'rabbit' shaped rocks sculptured by the desert winds for centuries. There are numerous places around such a landscape to take beautiful and interesting photos and just enjoy the works of nature.

Before returning to Cairo, the route will take you through Bahariya Oasis – a green desert oasis that looks like a green island in the middle of the desert. On the way, it is suggested to visit the <u>Black Desert</u>, where the ground is covered with dark volcanic stones, which is where the region's name comes from. You will also get to see other attractions such as the salt lake and the dunes' besides the narration being done by a Bedouin guide who gives information on the land and its features.
