## [Itinerary](#)

### **Day 1: Cairo - Bahariya Oasis tour - White Desert**

After arriving early morning at the chosen NEW Cairo hotel, take a splendid ride to Bahariya Oasis. On arrival to an air-conditioned car after one hour, our local Bedouin guide will be waiting to take you through the fresh green landscape of the oasis.

The first destination will be the internationally famous [Valley of the Golden Mummies](#) from where ten remarkable royal mummies were discovered, which had enlightened the world with the manner of burying them in ancient Egypt. Then go visit the [Tombs of the Nobles](#) – a social complex where you will comprehend the story of the rulers of the oases. Among the most significant are the Tomb of Zed-Amun-Ef-Ankh and the Tomb of Bannentiu the latter tomb was expanded for group burial because individual burials were not very effective.

On your tour, you will proceed to the Temple of Alexander where a temple was erected in honor of [Alexander the Great](#) for his brief stopover in Bahariya on his way to this remarkable Siwa Oasis. The last place visited during the tour involves the Temple of Ain El-Mefetla built in the [26th Dynasty](#). The archeologists from the 1990s have uncovered four more chapels which highlight more or less the the historical values of the place.

## Day 2: Back to Cairo

Try to have some tea in the morning, and a pleasant Bedouin breakfast full of energy on the sunny morning. Following breakfast drive off to the hot water springs through the marvelous [white desert](#) featuring snowy white limestone, naturally carved forms where you will be able to see shapes of mushrooms and rabbits.

During the rest of your Tour, you will travel back to Cairo through the green territory of Bahariya Oasis and the [Black Desert](#) which consists of black volcanic stones covering the Mountains. Commenting on the adventure your Bedouin guide will lead you to Salt Lake and the sand dunes in the vicinity to give an icing to the desert tour.

This memorable exploration will end when a driver takes you back to the bus terminal to continue with your journey back home.
