Day 2: The 18th Dynasty - Beit El Wali

After a delicious breakfast onboard, Enjoy this great tour back into ancient history in <u>Aswan</u>. First, one is taken to <u>Kalabsha Temple</u>, built during the <u>18th Dynasty</u> and dedicated to the gods <u>Amun-Re</u> and <u>Khnum</u>. It has been relocated from its earlier site since the 1960s to save it from submerging into water as a result of the construction of the Aswan High Dam.

He shares intriguing stories about the rich history and artistry used in constructing it. The next stop will be the **Beit El Wali**, an outstanding example of the architectural genius of that era. The temple is a tribute to Ramses II's victories and to the gods he so loved.

Lunch is provided at a local restaurant to sample the fare of the region. The Temple of **Abu Simbel** is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the most magnificent of all tributes to Ramses II. Beautiful landscapes and historical importance are combined in the **Wadi El Sebou**, an area that concludes the tour. The dinner in the onboard is a scrumptious ending to this tour.

Day 3: The Nubian Treasures

Your next stop is Abu Simbel by boat. It brags one of the most panoramic temple complexes in the world: the Temples of Abu Simbel. Hewn into the side of a mountain during the rule of Pharaoh Ramses II, it contains two temples with breathtaking carvings cut directly into the rock walls. These are to observe Ramses II and his queen, Nefertari, for her victory at the Battle of Kadesh.

After visiting these magnificent sites, you will be taken back to the ship for a delightful lunch, where you will have all the time for relaxation and recollection of the happenings of the day. Later, you will set off for dinner on board, pressed by marvelous night views of the Nile River, continuing your magical tour in Egypt.
