<u>Itinerary</u>

First Day: East Bank Investigation

Start your trip with Egypt Tours when the manager of Cairo Top Tours assists you in boarding the MS Nile Radamis Nile cruise in an air-conditioned car after meeting you at the <u>Luxor Airport</u>, train station, or hotel. Before visiting Luxor's East Bank, savor a delectable lunch buffet on board. Leading you to the magnificent <u>Karnak Temple</u>, your guide will honor the sun deity Amun-Ra, the goddess Mut, and their son, the moon god Khonsu. Proceed to the majestic <u>Luxor Temple</u>, a striking example of a New

Kingdom building. Later, while admiring the captivating scenery and experiencing an enthralling folkloric show, eat a delicious meal on board. Stay the night at Luxor on board. Lunch and dinner are served.

Day 2: Hatshepsut Temple and the Valley of the Kings Tours on the West Bank

You might take a hot air balloon ride over Luxor in the early morning for an added thrill. After that, depart for the West Bank of Luxor after savoring a substantial breakfast buffet on board the MS Nile Radamis. You will be taken to the Valley of the Kings by your private driver and Egyptologist guide, where you will discover more about the ancient Egyptian royal tombs. See the imposing Colossi of Memnon, and statues of King Amenhotep III, at the Temple of Hatshepsut, also called El-Deir El-Bahari. As the boat departs for Edfu, return to the cruise for lunch after your tour. Savor your meal on board and spend the evening in Edfu.

Meals: brunch, lunch, and dinner

Day 3: The Temples of Edfu and Kom Ombo

After enjoying a hearty breakfast on board, proceed to Edfu to explore the Temple of Horus, one of Egypt's best-preserved temples devoted to the falcon-headed god. After that, the cruise heads towards Aswan, stopping at Kom Ombo. Here, your guide will lead you to the unusual double temple honoring the crocodile gods Sobek and Haroeris. After there, the boat heads back to Aswan, where you'll have dinner on board and an evening Nubian spectacle.

Meals: brunch, lunch, and dinner

Day 4: Aswan Sightseeing Tour

After a delicious breakfast on board, you'll begin your Aswan day tours. Start with a visit to the impressive Aswan High Dam, which controls the Nile's water flow and generates electricity. Next, see the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u> in the granite quarries, believed to have been intended for Queen Hatshepsut. Continue to the stunning <u>Philae Temple</u>, dedicated to the goddess Isis. Later, enjoy lunch and dinner aboard your Nile cruise while soaking in the beautiful surroundings of Aswan. Overnight on the ship. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 5: Disembarkation from the Nile Cruise

The beautiful <u>Abu Simbel temples</u> were constructed by King Ramses II for himself and his beloved Queen Nefertari. On your last morning, you may want to consider going on an optional excursion to see them. Get ready to disembark from the MS Nile Radamis after breakfast. After that, your tour manager will take you to the train station or <u>Aswan Airport</u> to conclude your trip to Egypt. Breakfast is the meal.
