Day 1 :East Bank Exploration

Begin your adventure as our tour manager greets you at Luxor Airport, railway station, or Luxor hotel. You'll be transferred to an air-conditioned vehicle to board the MS Nile Radamis Nile cruise. Enjoy a delicious buffet lunch on board before starting your tour of Luxor's East Bank. Visit the awe-inspiring [Karnak Temple](#). Continue to the magnificent [Luxor Temple](#), a prominent site from the New Kingdom era. In the evening, dine aboard your cruise ship while enjoying an entertaining folkloric show, then spend the night in Luxor.

Day 2: West Bank Tours

Opt for a Hot Air Balloon Ride over Luxor if you're up for an early adventure. After breakfast on board, your Egyptologist guide and private driver will take you to the West Bank. Explore the Valley of the Kings and learn about the ancient tombs of Egyptian royalty. Visit the stunning [Temple of Hatshepsut](#), the Temple of El Deir El Bahari, and see the towering [Colossi of Memnon](#). After the tour, return to the cruise ship for lunch as you sail towards Edfu. Enjoy dinner on board and spend the night in Edfu.

Day 3: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

After a fresh breakfast, start your day with a visit to the Temple of Horus in [Edfu](#), where you'll learn about the falcon-headed god who protected the pharaohs. Continue sailing towards Aswan, stopping at [Kom Ombo](#) along the way. Here, visit the Temple of Kom Ombo, dedicated to the crocodile gods Sobek and Haroeris. Enjoy lunch on board as you sail to Aswan. End the day with dinner and a lively Nubian show on board.

Day 4: Aswan Sightseeing Tour

Begin your day with a hearty breakfast before heading out to explore Aswan. Visit the impressive [High Dam](#), which controls the Nile's flow and generates electricity. Next, see the Unfinished Obelisk in the granite quarries, likely intended for Queen Hatshepsut. End your tour at the beautiful [Philae Temple](#), dedicated to the goddess Isis. In the evening, savor your lunch and dinner on board while enjoying the sights of Aswan.

Day 5: Disembarkation from the Nile Cruise

Ramses II erected the magnificent Abu Simbel temples for himself and his wife, Nefertari, and you have the option to go on an optional tour of them on your last day. Prepare to disembark from the MS Nile Radamis after breakfast. Your tour manager will take you to the train station or [Aswan Airport](#) to conclude your trip to Egypt.
