Itinerary

Day 1: Arrivals to Cairo and Tour Saqqara and Pyramids of Dahshur

Cairo Top Tours has a tour manager who will assist you with all the necessary airport formalities,

including luggage, at the arrival hall of Cairo International Airport. Begin your Egypt day tour from the airport, or after the luggage has been kept at the hotel.

The first place to start for you is the <u>Giza Pyramids</u> and the Great Sphinx. Your guide as an expert will give a detailed narration on the construction and background of the pyramids of great Khufu, Khafre, and Menkaure.

The next stop will be <u>Saqqara</u> and its famous <u>Step Pyramid</u> of King Djoser, built by the architect Imhotep, which will be followed by a nice lunch.

Afterward, the group continues towards the <u>Dahshur Pyramids</u>—the Bent Pyramid and the <u>Red Pyramid</u> built by Senefru, King Cheops's father.

Complete the day with a trip to <u>Memphis</u>, the first capital ever constructed by King Menes.

Visit the remains of this ancient city, which contains a colossus of Ramses II and a sphinx made out of alabaster.

You shall be taken to your hotel for you to check-in, and you will spend your first night in Cairo.

Day 2: Discovering Alexandria

In the morning, have your meal and approach your guide and driver for more Egypt travel packages, which entail taking a day out to Alexandria.

Start with visiting the <u>Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa</u>, then Pompey's Pillar—a structure built in the memory of the Roman Emperor—Diocletian. Following that, proceed to the Crumbling <u>Citadel of Qaitbay</u>, built on the premises of one of the ancient Seven Wonders of the World—the lighthouse of Pharos.

Partake in a seafood meal and then head out to new cities to see the inbuilt <u>Alexandria library</u> and other tourist attractions in the city.

You shall also come back and spend the night in Cairo once again.

Day 3: Cairo Tour

After breakfast, start your day by touring the <u>Egyptian Museum's</u> extensive collection of antiquities, which includes King Tutankhamun's jewels.

Visit the magnificent Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque and the <u>Citadel of Saladin</u> after that.

See the <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>, the Church of St. Sergius, and the <u>Hanging Church</u> in Coptic Cairo after lunch.

Enjoy a coffee at <u>El Fishawy Café</u>, the Al Azhar Mosque, <u>Khan El Khalili market</u>, and a walk down El Moez Street in Islamic Cairo as you wind down your day.

Go back to your hotel to spend the night in Cairo. Includes breakfast and lunch.

Day 04: Cairo to Luxor

The morning meal is on the nuclear level; detailed checkout. Departure to the Cairo airport for a flight to Luxor comes next in course.

Upon arrival in Luxor, you will begin your West Bank tour, which includes the Valley of the Kings, where you will visit three tombs of wealthy kings, the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, and the two massive statues known as the Colossi of Memnon.

Subsequently, after lunch, continue on the Eastern Bank and sightsee the <u>Karnak Temple Complex</u> with the surrounding lined-up Avenue of Sphinxes, Karnak Hypostyle Hall, and more.

Finish the day with a tour of the <u>Luxor Temple</u>, which is one breathtaking piece of ancient Egyptian architecture.

Optional: Go and watch the light and sound show at the Karnak temple.

Luxor for the night.

Day 5: Luxor to Aswan

Prepare for an early breakfast and depart from Luxor to Aswan City.

On reaching Aswan, proceed for a visit to the <u>Aswan High Dam</u>, an important project that was commissioned by President Nasser.

Later, get on a boat to <u>Philae Temple</u> which houses monuments of different times such as the temples of Isis, Horus, and Hathor.

After enjoying a great lunch in Aswan, Check into the hotel you have been assigned to.

Day 06: Abu Simbel - Back to Cairo

Have breakfast and head out to visit the magnificent rock-hewn temples at Abu Simbel, constructed

by King Ramses II in honor of himself and his Queen, and proceed to the airport for the connecting flight to Cairo.

On arrival, you will be taken to your hotel, where it will be possible to check in.
