Day 1: Arrive in Cairo / Check-in / Overnight

Upon your arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, a Cairo Top Tours tour leader will assist you with the arrival procedures. You'll then be transported by a private vehicle to your hotel in Giza. Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Egyptian Museum, and Old Cairo Tour

After breakfast at the hotel, meet your English-speaking tour guide to start your tour of the Giza Pyramids. Visit the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, the Middle Pyramid of Chephren, and the Pyramid of Mycerinus. Explore the Valley Temple of Chephren and the <u>Great Sphinx</u>, Next, visit the Egyptian Museum, home to an extensive collection of Egyptian antiquities, including the treasures of Tutankhamun. Continue to <u>Coptic Cairo</u> to see the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon, the <u>Hanging Church</u>, the Church of Abu Serga, and the <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>. Enjoy lunch at a quality Egyptian restaurant before visiting the famous mosques of <u>Islamic Cairo</u> and Khan El Khalili bazaar.

Day 3: East Bank of Luxor Tour

Check out from your hotel in Giza and transfer to Cairo International Airport for a flight to Luxor. Upon arrival, you'll be greeted by our representative and start your Nile Cruise. After lunch on the cruise boat, visit the majestic <u>Luxor Temple</u>, built by King Amenhotep III and completed by subsequent kings. Enjoy dinner on board.

Day 4: West Bank of Luxor / Edfu

After breakfast on the cruise, explore the West Bank of Luxor, including the Colossi of Memnon, the Valley of the Kings, and the Temple of Hatshepsut. Enjoy lunch while sailing towards Edfu. In the evening, savor a buffet dinner followed by entertainment, musical shows, and belly dancing. Optional hot air balloon rides over Luxor are available for a breathtaking experience.

Day 5: Temples of Edfu and Kom Ombo

Enjoy breakfast on board before visiting the <u>Temple of Edfu</u>, dedicated to the god Horus. Sail to Kom Ombo to see the <u>Temple of Kom Ombo</u>, dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek and Haroeris. Have lunch on the cruise as it sails toward Aswan. Dinner will be served on board, accompanied by a Nubian show.

Day 6: Aswan Sightseeing

After breakfast, visit the highlights of Aswan, including The <u>High Dam</u> and the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, and enjoy dinner and overnight on board.
