Itinerary

Day1: Welcome to Buenos Aires

arrival in the city of Buenos Aires through international flight. Additionally to the variety of experiences and situations, it offers, it is now recognized as a lively, modern, and traditional city where European traditions exist in a harmonious fusion with Argentine realness. Assistance at the airport. Then Make your way to the hotel.

Day2: Exploring Buenos Aires

This guided city tour will cover the history, habits, and Argentine culture of the city that gave rise to the tango. The tour will start in the northern neighborhoods of Palermo and Recoleta, where you will see the typical sights—wide avenues, palaces, homes, and green spaces. The tour will proceed through the Centre, by the Teatro Colón and the Obelisco, a unique symbol of Argentina and Buenos Aires. The Government House, Metropolitan Cathedral, and Cabildo will all be visited, in addition to the historic Plaza de Mayo, where independence was declared in 1810. Next, the tour will head south to the smallest but most traditional neighborhood, San Telmo, and finally to La Boca, also referred to as "La Boca Republic." The excursion will comprise a stop at the Caminito passage, an open-air museum, and a photo opportunity in front of Boca Juniors Stadium, La Bombonera. The last neighborhood will be the newest, Puerto Madero.

Day3: Buenos Aires, Visit to a local "Estancia"

For the best examples of Argentine habits, Head to the province's center, Buenos Aires. Along with optional pursuits like horseback riding, regional games, and a typical Creole meal—the popular Argentine.

Day4: Travelling from Buenos Aires to Colonia (Uruguay)

We will travel by sea from Puerto Madero to the city of Colonia de Sacramento, where we will explore its historic center and see its oldest and most photographed streets, as well as museums, cafes, ice cream shops, and lovely souvenir shops that perfectly capture your unique Uruguayan identity.

Day5: Discovering Colonia and Punta del Este (Uruguay)

Our route to Punta del Este will take us there after breakfast. We will travel to Montevideo, the capital city, and its famous market, which is located in the centre of the historic district and offers a unique

blend of gastronomy, music, and art. Afterwards, we will reach Punta del Este, which is the most upscale city in the area and widely regarded as one of America's major spas. It's the most glitzy spa in America, with lavish summer homes, tall apartment buildings overlooking the water, enormous yachts anchored in the harbour and opulent hotels and dining establishments. Make your way to the hotel. You have the remainder of the day to yourself.

Day6: Explore Montevideo and Punta Del Este

Punta del Este, known as one of the main spas in America, is a luxurious city with luxurious summer homes, tall apartment buildings, yachts, hotels, and restaurants. The tour takes you to visit Piriapolis, the first spa in Uruguay, and its hills, where you can learn about the work of Don Francisco Piria, a visionary man. You'll visit the Castle of Piria, the Pan de Azúcar Hill reserve, Rambla Costanera, Argentinian Hotel Spa de Mar, Commercial and Sports Port, San Antonio Hill, panoramic views, and optional aerial chair descents. The tour then heads towards the Morro de Pan de Azucar, where two cable cars connect to the summit. The tour continues to the Maracanã Stadium and the Sambadrome, where the Samba musical rhythm is performed. The Metropolitan Cathedral of São Sebastião, a symbol of the metropolis, is also visited. The tour then continues to downtown Rio, where the local culture is explored through the Selaron stairs and Lapa arches. In the evening, an optional dinner at LASAI, OLYMPE, or OTEQUE restaurant is available. The tour offers a comprehensive view of Rio de Janeiro.

Day12: Continue discovering Rio de Janeiro

Rio offers a variety of beaches for visitors to enjoy. Copacabana, the most famous beach, is 4 km long and filled with colorful promenades. Ipanema is a favorite spot for surfers and divers, with nearby islands Palmas and Cagarras for underwater hunting and snorkeling. Arpoador, the 500-meter-long beach that separates Copacabana from Ipanema, is a popular spot for tourists and Cariocas to witness sunrises. Vermelha, located at the foot of Pan de Azúcar hill, is quiet and preferred by families with children and the elderly. Finally, Barra da Tijuca, the 18 km long longest beach in Rio, is a favorite among surfers for its green waters, windsurfing, kitesurfing, and coastal fishing. It also hosts spontaneous parties and is perfect for the youngest visitors.

Day13: Continue exploring Rio de Janeiro

Free day to enjoy the varied options of beaches that the city offers for us.

Day14: Rio de Janeiro beaches

Free day to take advantage of the many beaches the city has to offer.

Optional tour: A full-day trip to Ilha Grande and Angra dos Reis. Take a day trip to these well-known tropical islands and explore their enormous and enigmatic blue sea, which is home to shipwrecks, reefs, and a diverse array of marine life for those seeking an adventure they won't soon forget.
