Day 1: Arrival to Cairo

Day 2 : Giza Pyramids - Saqqara - Memphis

Your lovely day will start with your tasty breakfast in Cairo's hotel. Your <u>classic tours in Egypt</u> will start with the assistance of a professional Egyptologist from Cairo Top Tours, who will accompany you on an unforgettable tour of the <u>Giza Pyramids tour</u>. We'll start directly after breakfast by visiting the amazing Great Pyramid of King Cheops, which is considered the only surviving wonder from the ancient world. Here is your chance to see the grandeur of the **Sphinx** and the **Valley Temple of Khafra**, both linked with the great **King Chephren**, a builder of the second pyramid and the owner of the Great Sphinx. Before this wonder, we'll climb the high plateau; you can enjoy an optional camel ride at the Giza Pyramids and take some breathtaking views with the help of our experts.

You will then continue to the <u>Saqqara</u> necropolis, a site where the Pharaohs of Egypt built their kingdoms. You will step up, with your private driver and guide, to the <u>Step Pyramid</u> which was built for King Djoser, and many more impressive royal pyramids. You will also see the brightly painted and inscribed tombs of nobles showing scenes of daily life.
