Itinerary

Day 1 : Start from Aswan

Your journey begins with a certified tour guide meeting you at your hotel in Aswan, or at the <u>Aswan Airport</u> or railway station. You'll then proceed to embark on a 4-day Nile River Cruise from Aswan to Luxor aboard a 5-star Egypt Nile River Cruise, starting with an open-buffet lunch upon boarding. Following lunch, your exploration of Aswan commences with a visit to the <u>High Dam</u>, a renowned engineering marvel crucial to Egypt's modern history, providing flood control and ample power since its completion.

Continuing the Aswan excursions, you'll visit the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, believed to have been commissioned by <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> during the New Kingdom, situated in the red granite quarries. Next, a motorboat ride takes you to the stunning <u>Philae Temple</u> on Agilika Island, an ancient site central to the myth of Isis and Osiris. After concluding the Aswan tours, you'll return to the Nile cruise boat for dinner and an overnight stay in Aswan.

Meals included: Lunch and dinner.

Day 2: Set sail for Edfu and visit the Kom-Ombo Temple

After enjoying a delightful breakfast aboard your cruise ship, you will have the option to participate in an additional tour of Abu Simbel.

Following lunch, the Nile cruise will depart for Kom Ombo. Upon arrival, you will visit the <u>Kom Ombo</u> <u>Temple</u>, historically notable for its association with the training of African elephants for military purposes. This temple venerates the crocodile <u>god Sobek</u> and Haroeris, a form of the god Horus. As the day concludes, the ship will proceed to Edfu, where you will enjoy dinner on board and spend the night.

Meals provided: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

Day 3: Visitation to Edfu Temple

Start your day with a delicious breakfast aboard the MS Nile Radamis Nile River Cruise. Following breakfast, you will ride a horse-drawn carriage through <u>Edfu</u> town to visit the <u>Temple of Horus</u>. After the tour, lunch will be served on the boat. Enjoy afternoon tea as the ship continues its journey towards Luxor. Upon arrival, you will stay overnight in Luxor.

In the evening, you have the choice to participate in an optional excursion to the <u>sound and light show</u> at Karnak Temple.

Meals provided: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

Day 4: Exploration Tour to Luxor East and West Bank

On the final day of your tour, begin with a satisfying breakfast aboard the cruise before checking out. You will then embark on a comprehensive Luxor day tour led by our professional guide, covering both the <u>East and West Banks</u>. Your exploration starts at the <u>Karnak Temples</u>, constructed over centuries by various pharaohs from 2200 to 360 B.C. Following this, visit the <u>Luxor Temple</u>, built between 1400 and 1000 B.C. under the reigns of Pharaohs Amenhotep III and Ramses II.

Continue your tour on the <u>West Bank</u> with a visit to the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, renowned for its numerous royal tombs. Anciently named "Ta Iset Maat," translating to "place of truth," this site holds historical significance. You will also explore the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u>, an architectural marvel by Senenmut dedicated to the pharaoh Hatshepsut, the only woman to rule Egypt extensively. Additionally, view the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>. After completing the tour, transfer to your desired location in Luxor.

In the early morning, you may opt to join an excursion for a hot air balloon ride over Luxor.
