Day 1: Say Hi from Luxor. A visit to East Bank

One of the tour's highlights is the 1884 discovery of the <u>Luxor Temple</u> on the East Bank of the Nile. Following the tours of Luxor, you will spend the night on the MS Royal Viking Nile Cruise.

An optional show with <u>music and lights</u>. at the <u>Karnak Temple</u> is available. Lunch and dinner are included in the tour.

Day 2: A visit to Luxor West Bank

Your tour concludes with a visit to the unique site of King Amenhotep III.

After a morning full of discoveries, you'll return to the cruise ship for a tasty lunch as you sail towards Edfu. If you're feeling adventurous.

you can have an optional trip for a Luxor <u>Hot Air Balloon Ride</u>, offering stunning views above the tombstones of the West Bank. In the evening, you'll enjoy a delightful dinner on board and spend a restful night on the <u>Nile Cruise</u> in Edfu.

Day 3: A Discovery tour to Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples
