Itinerary

Day 1: Hi From Luxor East Bank Tours

You will be picked up from your hotel in Luxor and transferred by our representative to your 5-day Nile Cruise Tour from Luxor to Aswan. Upon arrival, our tour leader will provide you with the keys to your cabin. After a brief rest, enjoy your first lunch on board the MS Royal Viking Nile Cruise.

Meet your English-speaking Egyptologist guide in the lobby to begin your <u>Luxor East Bank Tours</u>. Luxor, located 700 kilometers south of Cairo and home to nearly 500,000 residents, thrives on tourism and agriculture. First, visit the magnificent Karnak Temple, the largest temple in Egypt, which evolved over 2000 years from a simple shrine during the <u>New Kingdom</u> into a vast complex. Next, continue your Luxor excursions with a visit to the impressive <u>Luxor Temple</u>, discovered in 1884 and situated on the East Bank of the Nile in Luxor. After the tour, spend the night onboard as you prepare for the next day's adventures.

You can also optional tour for an additional **Sound and Light Show** at Karnak Temple.

Meals included: Lunch and dinner.

Day 2: A trip to Luxor West Bank Tours

After enjoying a delicious breakfast aboard the MS Royal Viking Nile Cruise, meet your tour leader to begin your West Bank tour of Luxor. Your first stop will be the magnificent rock-cut tombs of the New Kingdom Pharaohs in the Valley of the Kings. Built far from the reach of tomb thieves, over 60 tombs have been discovered carved into the rocks.

Next, visit the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u>, also known as the <u>Temple of El Deir El Bahari</u>. Standing at 97 feet (30 meters) tall, this extraordinary monument never fails to overwhelm its visitors. Your final stop on the Luxor West Bank tour will be the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, the towering statue of King Amenhotep III. After the tour, return to the cruise for a tasty lunch as you sail towards Edfu.

Optionally, you can enjoy a <u>Luxor Hot Air Balloon Ride</u> above the West Bank monuments. In the evening, a delightful dinner will be served, and you will stay overnight aboard the Nile Cruise in Edfu.

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

Day 3: Discover the Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

After two days of exploring Luxor's remarkable sites, start your day with a tasty breakfast aboard the Nile Cruise. Accompanied by your expert tour guide, embark on one of the most captivating Egypt Day Tours: a visit to the Temple of Horus in Edfu. The Temple of Edfu, one of the largest in Egypt (second only to Karnak Temple), is exceptionally well-preserved and retains all the elements of an ancient Egyptian temple.

Return to the cruise ship and enjoy a delightful sail southward to Kom Ombo, where a unique lunch will be served aboard. Upon arriving in Kom Ombo, visit the incredible Kom Ombo Temple, dedicated to the crocodile <u>god Sobek</u>. Constructed between 1350 and 180 B.C. under King Ramses II, this

temple is a marvel to explore.

After completing your tours of <u>Kom Ombo</u> and <u>Edfu</u>, the boat will continue its journey towards Aswan. Enjoy a delicious dinner aboard the cruise, followed by entertainment and a local music show. Spend the night in the beautiful city of Aswan.

Day 4: Amazing Aswan Nile Cruise Tour

Start your day with breakfast aboard your Egypt Nile cruise, then meet your private tour guide for Aswan Excursions:

The High Dam:

Explore the High Dam, which protects Egypt from Nile floods, preventing wasted water. Aswan, Egypt's southernmost city, lies at the first Nile waterfall, nearly a thousand kilometers from Cairo.

The Unfinished Obelisk:

Visit the granite quarries where ancient Egyptians cut and transported granite for the pyramids and temples during Egypt's Old and New Kingdoms.

Philae Temple:

Continue to the <u>Philae Temple</u>, built in Greco-Roman style to honor Goddess Isis, central to the myth of Isis, Osiris, and Horus.

Return to the cruise for lunch, enjoy free time in Aswan, and in the evening, dine aboard with a quality dinner and an entertaining Nubian show. Overnight in Aswan.

Day 5: Last Day of the 5-Days tour from Luxor

After checking out from the Luxor-Aswan Nile cruise and enjoying your final breakfast onboard, we will transfer you to your chosen drop-off point in Aswan, such as the <u>Aswan Airport</u>.

You also have the option to take a tour of <u>Abu Simbel</u> on your last day to complement your amazing excursions in Aswan!
