Itinerary

Day 1: A tour in Aswan

On the first day, your certified tour guide will greet you at your hotel in Aswan, the <u>Aswan Airport</u>, or the Aswan railway station. You will then be transferred to commence your 4-day Nile River Cruise from Aswan to Luxor. Upon boarding your 5-star Nile River Cruise, you will enjoy an open-buffet lunch. After lunch, your Aswan excursions will begin with a visit to the High Dam. This special engineering feat, one of the most significant projects in modern Egyptian history, has protected the country from the annual Nile floods and provided a reliable power source for the nation.

Next, you will visit the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, located in the granite quarries. This obelisk, believed to have been commissioned by <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> during the New Kingdom, offers insight into ancient Egyptian stoneworking techniques.

Following this, you will take a motorboat to the <u>Philae Temple</u> on Agilika Island. Known as Philae in Greek and Pilak in ancient Egyptian, meaning "the end," this temple is integral to the myth of Isis and Osiris. After completing the Aswan tours, you will return to the Nile cruise boat for dinner and an overnight stay in Aswan.

Meals included: Lunch and dinner.

Day 2: Visit Kom-Ombo Temple and Sail to Edfu

After enjoying a sumptuous breakfast on your cruise, you will have the option to take an additional tour to Abu Simbel.

Following lunch, the Nile cruise will set sail towards Kom Ombo. Upon arrival, you will visit the <u>Kom Ombo Temple</u>, historically significant for raising and training African elephants for military use. This temple is dedicated to the crocodile <u>god Sobek</u> and one of the manifestations of the god Horus, known as Haroeris. As the day concludes, the ship will continue its journey to the town of Edfu while you dine on board, with an overnight stay at Edfu.

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

Day 3: A trip to Edfu Temple

Begin your day with a delightful breakfast aboard the MS Nile Radamis Nile River Cruise. Following breakfast, you will take a horse-drawn carriage through the town of <u>Edfu</u> to visit the <u>Temple of Horus</u>. After the tour, lunch will be served aboard the boat. Enjoy afternoon tea as the ship continues its voyage towards Luxor. Upon arrival, you will spend the night in Luxor.

In the evening, you have the opportunity to attend an optional excursion to the <u>sound and light show</u> at Karnak Temple.

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

Day 4: Luxor East and West Bank Tours

On the final day of your tour, enjoy a delicious breakfast aboard the cruise before checking out. You will then venture on a comprehensive Luxor day tour, covering both the <u>East and West Banks</u>, accompanied by our professional guide. Your tour will begin with a visit to the magnificent <u>Karnak Temples</u>, constructed by various pharaohs between 2200 and 360 B.C. Following this, you will explore the <u>Luxor Temple</u>, built between 1400 and 1000 B.C. by Pharaohs Amenhotep III and Ramses II.

The tour will continue on the West Bank with a visit to the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, where numerous royal tombs can be found. In ancient times, this valley was known as "Ta Iset Maat," meaning "place of truth." You will also visit the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u>, designed by the architect Senenmut and dedicated to Hatshepsut, the only woman who ruled Egypt for an extended period. Additionally, you will see the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>. After completing the tour, you will be transferred to your preferred destination in Luxor.

In the early morning, you have the option to join an excursion for a hot air balloon ride over Luxor.
