Day 1: Tours of Luxor East Bank/Embarkation

You will be picked up from your hotel in Luxor. Our representative will transfer you to your 5-Day Nile Cruise Tour from Luxor to Aswan. Upon arrival, our tour leader will give you the keys to your cabin and let you have a short break before getting your first lunch meal on board the MS Royal Viking Nile Cruise.

After lunch, in the hotel lobby, you will be introduced to your English-speaking Egyptologist guide to start your <u>Luxor East Bank Tour</u>. Luxor is a city of almost 500,000 inhabitants living 700 kilometers south of Cairo, and its survival depends upon tourism and agriculture. Your first stop will be the magnificent Karnak Temple, the biggest temple in Egypt. It began with just a simple average shrine for the <u>New Kingdom</u> period that, in a period of over 2000 years, evolved into this vast complex. Next on your Luxor tour will be the exquisite <u>Luxor Temple</u> on the East Bank of the Nile in Luxor. Uncovered in 1884, and therefore next, after all these Luxor tours, we'll get aboard for an overnight stay in continuation of your journey the following day.

You also have the option to attend a <u>Sound and Light Show at Karnak Temple</u>. Lunch and Dinner are meals included.

Day 2: Continue exploring Luxor West Bank

You will meet your tour guide to start your <u>West Bank tour of Luxor</u> after enjoying your tasty breakfast aboard the MS Royal Viking Nile Cruise. Here, you will see the magnificent stone-cut tombs of the New Kingdom pharaohs, also known as the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, where they built their tombs very far away from the tomb thieves. To date, more than 60 tombs carved into the rocks have been discovered. Additionally, proceed with Luxor West Bank Tours to see <u>the Colossi of Memnon</u>, the enormous statues of Queen Hatshepsut that stand thirty meters (nine stories) tall, and the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u>, also known as <u>the Temple of El Deir El Bahari</u>. the great King Amenhotep III will be your last Luxor day tour. Your delicious lunch will be served aboard <u>the Luxor to Aswan Nile Cruise</u> and then you will enjoy cruising to Edfu.

Optional: Luxor Hot Air Balloon Ride beyond the west bank tombstones.

In the evening your lovely dinner will be done and you will stay overnight aboard the Nile Cruise in Edfu

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 3: Discovering Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

After spending the previous two days on Luxor sightseeing tours, you will now enjoy a delicious breakfast on board the Nile Cruise. You will also be joined by your acquainted tour guide for one of the most charming Egypt day tours. He will take you to Edfu to visit the <u>Temple of Horus</u>, which is one of the largest and best-preserved Egyptian temples, having kept all of its authentic parts. Afterward, you will return to the cruise ship and enjoy a fascinating sail southward until you reach Kom Ombo, where you will have a unique lunch on board.

Once you reach Kom Ombo, you will be taken to see the amazing Kom Ombo Temple, which honours

the crocodile god <u>Sobek</u>. Built between 1350 and 180 B.C. on King Ramses II's orders, the temple is dedicated to the crocodile god. After your <u>tour of Kom Ombo and Edfu</u> is over, enjoy a delicious dinner on board the cruise, local music and entertainment, and an overnight stay in the stunning city of Aswan.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 4: Aswan Nile Cruise Trip

You'll meet your private tour guide and have breakfast to begin your day on your Egypt Nile cruise. After that, you'll visit Aswan, Egypt's southernmost city, which is situated near the first waterfall on the Nile. You will see the High Dam, which kept Egypt safe from flooding caused by the Nile. Egypt's southernmost city, Aswan, is situated close to Cairo. You will also see the Unfinished Obelisk, where pyramids and temples built by the ancient Egyptians were constructed using granite quarries. Out of the four locations where the stories of Isis, Osiris, and Horus took place, one is the Greco-Roman-styled temple dedicated to the goddess Isis, known as the Philae Temple. You'll have the afternoon to yourself in Aswan after lunch. You'll enjoy a delicious dinner on the cruise ship in the evening and take in a fascinating Nubian show.

Day 5: Finishing the 5 Day Nile Cruise Tour from Luxor to Aswan

Once you have finished your final breakfast on the tour and checked out of the Luxor Aswan Nile cruise boat, we will transport you to the <u>Aswan airport</u>, depending on where you have requested to be dropped off.

On the final day of the incredible Aswan excursions, there is an optional tour to <u>Abu Simbel!</u> Meals: Breakfast
