Day 1: Arrive Cairo / Check-in / Overnight

You will then be transported by private vehicle to your hotel in Giza. Day 2: Tour of the Giza Pyramids, Egyptian Museum, and Old Cairo

After breakfast, your English-speaking tour guide will meet you at the hotel to begin your tour of the Giza Pyramids, including the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, the Middle Pyramid of King Chephren, and the Pyramid of King Mycerinus. You will also visit the Valley Temple of King Chephren and the iconic Great Sphinx.

Next, you'll visit the Egyptian Museum, home to the world's largest collection of Egyptian antiquities, including the treasures of King Tutankhamun.

Your tour continues in <u>Coptic Cairo</u>, visiting the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon, <u>the Hanging Church</u>, the Church of Abu Serga, and the Ben Ezra Synagogue. After enjoying lunch at a quality Egyptian restaurant, you'll explore Islamic Cairo, visiting famous mosques and the bustling <u>Khan El Khalili</u> bazaar before returning to your hotel.

Day 3: East Bank of Luxor Tour

You will be taken to Cairo International Airport for your journey to Luxor after leaving your hotel in Giza. After helping you upon arrival, our representative will take you on a Nile Cruise. You will travel the East Bank of Luxor after lunch on board, stopping to see the magnificent Luxor Temple.

You will spend the night cruising the Nile River, with dinner served on board.

Day 4: West Bank of Luxor / Edfu

Your tour guide will take you to the West Bank of Luxor to view the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u>, <u>the Valley of the Kings</u>, and <u>the Colossi of Memnon</u> after breakfast on the boat. While traveling toward <u>Edfu</u>, savor your meal. Enjoy a buffet dinner and entertainment in the evening, which includes belly dance and musical acts.

You have the option of taking a hot air balloon ride over Luxor to get an amazing perspective of the surrounding scenery along the Nile and the ancient ruins.

You will travel to <u>Kom Ombo</u> to see the Temple of Kom Ombo, which is devoted to the crocodile gods Sobek and Haroeris, after breakfast on board. You'll go to the Edfu Temple as well. As you sail approaching the <u>Aswan day tour</u>, savor lunch.

There will be a Nubian show after dinner is served on board. Spend the night aboard the cruise at Aswan.

You will tour Aswan after breakfast on the boat, stopping at the High Dam and the Unfinished Obelisk, which was probably commissioned by Queen Hatshepsut.
