#### <u>Itinerary</u>

#### Day 1: Arriving in Cairo for Sakkara and Dahshur Pyramids

A tour manager will assist you with the arrival procedures upon getting to Cairo International Airport.

Begin the day trip in Cairo by visiting the <u>Giza Pyramids</u> and Sphinx. Find out how they were built in ancient times, what the lives of Pharaohs like Cheops, Chephren, Mycerinus, etc. are, and much more.

At lunchtime, head towards the Imhotep's designed Saggara Step Pyramid. Go on to explore the Red

Pyramid of King Senefru as well as the Bent Pyramid at the Dahshur Pyramids in the afternoon.

Lastly, we head to Memphis today.

For almost three millennia after the amalgamation of Upper and Lower Egypt, this location served as the King of Ancient Egypt's palace as well as a center of political and administrative

After that, the night shall be spent at your Cairo hotel.

#### Day 2 of the sightseeing tour in Alexandria.

The following day after having breakfast you will be met by a driver and a tour guide and proceed for a sightseeing trip to the city of Alexandria, founded by Alexander the Great in 332 B.C.

After exploring the Kom El Shoqafa Catacombs, go on to examine Pompey's Pillar.

Following that, enjoy the views of the Mediterranean Sea at the <u>Citadel of Qaitbay</u> which stands on the ruins of the ancient lighthouse, Pharos of Alexandria.

After a lunch of fish and shellfish, continue with the Tour of the Modern Bibliotheca of Alexandria.

By that time all the major sights of the city will have been visited and you will fly back to Cairo in the evening.

Meals offered include breakfast and lunch.

### **Day 3: Cairo Tour**

After breakfast head off to the <u>Egyptian Museum</u> to see its rich collection of artifacts including the treasures of King Tutankhamun.

Then, proceed to the <u>Citadel of Saladin</u> and visit the Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque.

After having your lunch, go to <u>Coptic Cairo</u> and proceed to the Hanging Church, the <u>St Sergius Church</u>, and the Ben Ezra Synagogue. Empire of Islam Cairo experienced a short walk along El Moez Street with a visit to the <u>Khan-el-Khalili bazaar</u>, stopping for Egyptian coffee at El Fishawy café.

Go back to your hotel for a rest.

Meals included: Breakfast and lunch.

#### Day 04: Cairo to Luxor

After having breakfast at your hotel, proceed to the airport in time to catch your flight to Luxor. Upon arrival, we start the West Bank tour visiting the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u>,

and the Colossi of Memnon.

After having lunch, we carry on with the East Bank tour with a trip to the <u>Karnak Temple complex</u>, going down the Avenue of the Sphinxes and enjoying the beautiful temple, that includes Queen Hatshepsut's Obelisk and the sacred lake. Conclude the day with a visit to the Luxor Temple.

Add on: Sound and Light Show at the Karnak Temple.

Enjoy the night in Luxor. Meals: Breakfast and lunch.

#### Day 05: Luxor to Aswan

After breakfast and the morning checkout at around 8:00 AM, you will travel overland from Luxor towards Aswan for an estimated duration of around 3 hours.

After arriving in Aswan, your first stop will be the <u>Aswan Dam</u> – a significant project in the economic growth-based developments of the country. Afterward, make your way to <u>Philae Temple</u> by a boat where different eras of monuments can be witnessed including those of Pharaonic, Ptolemaic, Roman, and even Christian times.

Relax with a nice lunch following your tours in Aswan before proceeding to harbor your hotel.

Spend the night at Aswan.

Meals included: Breakfast and lunch.

## Day 06: Transfer from Abu Simbel to Cairo

Following the meal, your Egyptologist will meet you at your hotel and take you for a tour of the splendid temples of <u>Abu Simbel</u> which were constructed during the period of Ramses II.

You will return to Aswan, and after that, you will move to <u>Aswan airport</u> for your flight back to Cairo.

When you arrive in Cairo, the representative will take you to the hotel to check in and stay overnight.
