Day 1: Arrival in Luxor

Your adventure begins in Luxor, the world's greatest open-air museum. Upon arrival, you'll be greeted and transferred to your luxurious hotel.

Enjoy a delicious buffet lunch aboard the vessel before embarking on your East Bank tour of Luxor. Your guide will lead you to the magnificent [Karnak Temple](#), dedicated to the ancient Egyptian deities—the sun god Amun-Ra, the goddess Mut, and their son, the moon god Khonso. Next, you'll visit the splendid [Luxor Temple](#), a renowned temple from the New Kingdom era located on the East Bank of the timeless Nile River.

As the evening sets in, savor a delightful dinner aboard your Nile cruise ship while taking in the stunning views and enjoying a captivating folkloric show.

Overnight stay in Luxor.

Meals: Lunch, Dinner.

Day 2: West Bank Tour (Valley of the Kings and Queen Hatshepsut Temple)

Start your day with an optional Hot Air Balloon Ride over Luxor for an exhilarating adventure. After an early morning open buffet breakfast aboard the MS Nile Radamis Nile Cruise, your Egyptologist guide and private driver will take you to the West Bank of Luxor. Your first stop is the Valley of the Kings, where you'll receive a detailed explanation of the royal tombs' construction in ancient Egypt.

Next, visit the [Temple of Hatshepsut](#), also known as El Dier El Bahari, followed by the impressive [Colossi of Memnon](#), the giant statues of King Amenhotep III. After the tour, return to the cruise for a delicious lunch on board as the boat sets sail for Edfu.

Enjoy dinner on board and spend the night in Edfu. *Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.*

Day 3: Visit Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

Begin your day with a fresh breakfast aboard the Nile cruise. Your guide will then accompany you to explore the Temple of Horus in [Edfu](#), dedicated to the falcon-headed god, protector of kingship. After the visit, the boat will sail toward Aswan. On the way, enjoy a tasty lunch on board before stopping at the small town of Kom Ombo. Here, you'll visit the Ptolemaic [Temple of Kom Ombo](#), dedicated to the crocodile gods Sobek and Haroeris.

Continue sailing down the Nile to Aswan, where you'll enjoy dinner on board and a Nubian show in the evening. *Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.*

Day 4: Aswan Sightseeing Tour

Start your day with an open buffet breakfast on board before setting out on a tour of Aswan. Begin with a visit to the [High Dam](#), an engineering marvel built to control the Nile's flow, generate electricity, and provide water for agriculture. Next, see the Unfinished Obelisk, a massive monument in the granite quarries that was never completed, possibly intended for Queen Hatshepsut. Finally, visit the [Philae Temple](#), dedicated to the goddess Isis, showcasing the architectural style of the Greco-Roman era. Return to the cruise for lunch, and later, enjoy dinner on board while spending the night in Aswan.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 5: Disembarkation from the Nile Cruise

In the morning, you have the option to visit the majestic Abu Simbel temples, built by King Ramses II for himself and his beloved wife, Queen Nefertari. After your final breakfast, prepare for disembarkation from the MS Nile Radamis Nile Cruise. Your tour manager will assist with your transfer to [Aswan Airport](#) or the railway station, marking the end of your Egypt travel package.
