<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Tour to Giza pyramids, Egyptian Museum and Old Cairo

The voyage starts in Giza, where you can visit the enormous <u>sphinx</u>, which is shaped like a lion with a pharaoh's head on top, as well as the more than 4,500-year-old <u>Giza pyramids</u>. Our Egyptologist will also go into the historical building methods used to build these structures

Our next trip will be the Egyptian Museum in Tahrir, which is one of Egypt's most significant museums because it has the most extensive displays connected to ancient Egyptian history. This exhibit showcases some extraordinary treasures that belonged to Pharaohs and their ancestors, including the spectacular tombs of King Tutankhamun and the intriguing room of mummified animals. Additionally, it has more than 100,000 artifacts from many cultures that have had a variety of influences on Ancient Egyptian Civilization over the course of thousands of years.

After that, we'll have lunch in Cairo at a real Egyptian restaurant. From this point on, we will visit the Islamic section of <u>old Cairo</u> as part of our trip. <u>The Saladin Citadel</u> trip will be the first stop on the journey. You may visit this magnificent citadel's "Mohamed Ali Mosque" and take in the fortifications while there. It is important to note that from this fortress, you can see the entire ancient city from a wide angle.

You will go to Coptic Cairo, the Christian area of the city, at the conclusion of this historical trip. You may see the Ben Ezra Synagogue, the Hanging Church, and the Church of St. Sergius also called the Church of the Cave, where the Holy Family hid during their departure to Egypt.

Finally, after such a program in the magnificent towns of Cairo and Giza, we drive you back to your accommodation.

Day 2: Baharia Oasis and White desert tour

The day trip departs from your hotel in Cairo at 7:00 AM and travels through the surrounding desert regions. Our first stop of the day will be the stunning Bahariya Oasis, a desert that is recognized throughout the world for its enticing beauty and spectacular landscapes.

We would change from the minibus to the jeep when we arrived, then we would begin traveling to the Western Desert. Get ready for an unforgettable desert adventure loaded with thrilling thrills. Tour the oasis with the aid of your guide, taking in the vast surroundings of shady palm trees and natural springs.

After lunch, continue your tour of <u>the white desert</u> and make a pit stop in the nearby Agabat, a breathtaking valley with imposing white cliff walls and yellow limestone cliffs. You can practice sandboarding on the sand dunes here with a Jeep 4x4. A few sand dunes can be climbed for endless views.

After traveling deep into the desert, we would eventually arrive at the volcanic mountains, which

resemble volcanic cones and rise from the desert. We would journey to the black basalt-covered volcanic summit known as <u>Al- Marsous</u>. To acquire a comprehensive perspective of the Oasis's surroundings, let's pause at the viewpoint.

You will visit Egypt's <u>Crystal Mountain</u> as your final stop. This stunning desert site is covered in abasalt covering that is black. The environment has a certain air of mystery thanks to the sunglittering crystals. Although there are minerals nearby, you shouldn't take any with you.

Our excursion will come to a conclusion at around 10 PM when our tour guide and driver return you to your Cairo hotel.

Day 3: Alexandria attractions

Our tour guide will be waiting for you in the hotel lobby at around 6:30 a.m. for a lovely day excursion to Alexandria. We will travel to Alexandria, Egypt's most important Mediterranean city, from Cairo.

Visit the Citadel of Qaitbey, a 15th-century stronghold with ruins of the Alexandria lighthouse, and Kom el Shogafa, the largest Roman cemetery with over 300 mummies and Greco-Roman themes.

Enjoy Egyptian delicacies at a seafood restaurant, visit Pompey Column and Serapeus Temple Ruins, and rest at <u>Pompay Pillar</u>, where historians suggest Roman general was buried.

You will visit the Bibliotheca Alexandrina, one of the most significant cultural hubs in the eastern Mediterranean, at the end of the day. We will ultimately take you back to your Cairo hotel in the late afternoon.

Day 4: Final departure

On the final day, our tour guide will be there to pick you up in the hotel lobby at the appointed hour so you can be driven back to the Cairo airport and depart Egypt with fresh experiences, breathtaking images, and immeasurable memories.
