Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive to Cairo

Our knowledgeable tour guide will meet you at the <u>Cairo International Airport</u> and drive you to your Cairo hotel, where you may check-in without delay. He will make sure that all pick-up times for the <u>Egypt luxury tours from Australia</u> which begin with a visit to the <u>Giza Pyramids</u> of Egypt are accurate. Spend the night getting ready for your next adventures.

At the hotel, a welcome drink will be served.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids and Sphinx tour

Begin your 12-day group travel package on the second day with a half-day tour of the <u>Sphinx</u> and the Giza Pyramids. When we go to the Giza pyramid plateau, we will pick you up at your Cairo hotel at 9:00 AM and take you to see the Great Pyramid of Cheops, the Pyramid of Chephren, and the Pyramid of Mycerinus.

You will visit the Great Pyramid, which is One of the most amazing constructions that was built ever by humans. The construction took more than 20 years, and the builders used only copper tools! It was finished about 2560 B.C.

The Great Pyramid is considered one of the Seven Wonders of the World because it has survived for a long time without being destroyed or damaged by earthquakes or other natural disasters.

We'll visit the Great <u>Sphinx</u> after seeing the Pyramids. The Sphinx is a stone monument from around 4500 B.C. with a human head and lion's body; it is one of the oldest monuments still standing today!

If you have time left over, you can take a camel ride through a nearby desert village to sample authentic Egyptian cuisine and buy souvenirs!

Following this <u>Egypt Classic tours from Australia</u> we will return to your Cairo hotel for some free time, and overnight stay.

Day 3: Alexandria Tour

After breakfast in the hotel, you'll embark on a day trip to Alexandria from Cairo, a 2-hour drive away. This is a diverse city and one of Egypt's most popular tourist destinations. You'll have time to explore on your own, such as walking along the Corniche, a waterfront promenade that runs along the Mediterranean Sea.

The <u>Bibliotheca of Alexandria</u>, which was built in 300 BC, will be visible. You'll also see the Tomb of Alexander the Great and <u>Pompey's Pillar</u>, which was built for Pompey Magnus in 331 BC, as well as the <u>Citadel of Qaitbay</u>, which is an important military structure built in the 15th century on the Mediterranean coast where the famous lighthouse Pharos (one of the world's seven artificial wonders) once stood.

Enjoy delicious fresh seafood at a high-quality restaurant before retiring to your Alexandria hotel for the night.

Day 4: Back to Cairo | Egyptian Museum | Train to Aswan

We will return to Cairo after breakfast to continue your amazing <u>Cairo day tours</u>. Today, we'll go to one of the world's most famous museums: the <u>Egyptian Museum</u> in Cairo, where you can see King Tutankhamun's treasures, including the only royal treasure discovered in excellent condition, as well as those of other pharaohs. If you want to see the Egyptian Museum, you must arrive early. The museum is massive and packed with fascinating artifacts, including mummies, sarcophagi, and funerary statuary.

Before leaving for the train station to catch the sleeper train to Aswan and spend the night in your hotel, you will be served a delicious lunch in a well-known local restaurant.

Day 5: Arrive to Aswan | Aswan Excursions

After breakfast aboard the train, you will disembark at Aswan train station to begin your Aswan tour, which will include stops at the <u>High Dam</u> and the Philae Temple, both of which offer stunning views of the Nile River. The Aswan High Dam is an engineering marvel that has transformed the lives of millions of Egyptians and Sudanese. You will be transferred to this popular site by a private and air-conditioned vehicle from Aswan. Following that, you'll go to the <u>Philae Temple</u>, which is now submerged beneath Lake Nasser but can still be seen by boat.

After lunch, you will have time to relax before returning to your Aswan hotel and spend the night there.

Day 6: Abu Simbel Temple

You'll start your journey to <u>Abu Simbel temples</u> today. A visit to Abu Simbel would be incomplete without seeing the temples, which were built to honor Pharaoh Ramesses II and his wife. Rameses II, Egypt's greatest builder at the time, erected these massive structures in the 13th century BC. The temple is carved into the side of a mountain and houses two Rameses II statues. The <u>Egypt Easter</u> tours from Australia will take you through the interior of the temple, where you will see ornate decorations. You will also have the opportunity to enter the rock-hewn boat, which was carved from a single piece of granite.

Day 7: Aswan to Luxor | Luxor Temple

This morning, we'll leave Aswan for Luxor, which is the world's largest open-air museum and the capital of Egypt's new kingdom golden age! Begin your Luxor tours with a visit to the great <u>Temple of Luxor</u>, which is one of ancient Egypt's most important temples dating back to 1400 BC. King Amenhotep III began the construction of this ancient temple in the Eighteenth Dynasty (New Kingdom) and was completed by Ramesses II in the Nineteenth Dynasty. It is situated on the Nile's eastern bank. Numerous pharaohs' statues will be on display, including Ramesses II's golden mask and Seti I's statue of himself making offerings to Amun Ra.

Following that, you will be transferred to your Luxor hotel.

Day 8: Luxor West Bank Tour | Transfer to Hurghada by Land

Breakfast will be served at your Luxor hotel before meeting your certified tour guide and private

driver to continue our Egypt group tour packages to the East Bank of Luxor tour. Today we will visit the <u>Karnak Temple</u> complex, which is one of Egypt's largest and most important religious sites. The temple was constructed over several hundred years and contains numerous structures such as festival halls, sanctuaries, and pylons. You will visit Egypt's most famous monuments. The <u>Hatshepsut</u> <u>Temple</u> at Deir Al-Bahari should be your first stop. This limestone structure was built to honor Queen Hatshepsut's achievements and to serve as a burial temple and shrine to Amun Re. Following that, you'll see the <u>Valley of the Kings</u> and the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u> before continuing overland for a threehour drive to Hurghada, where you'll spend the night in a hotel.

Day 9: Submarine Excursion in Hurghada

Have a delicious breakfast before beginning your exciting Hurghada tours. We'll take a two-hour dive on Sindbad Submarine to see <u>the Red Sea</u>'s unique marine life and colorful coral reefs. We'll be taken on a nice dive under the water as the only Middle Eastern submarine with 44 passengers. It will travel 22 meters beneath the sea, where it will encounter a diverse range of marine life. You don't have to be a scuba diver to participate. After the trip, you will be returned to your Hurghada hotel.

Day 10: Free Day in Hurghada

There are no scheduled activities in Hurghada on this day; you will eat a delicious breakfast at the hotel and spend the day as you wish, or you can choose one of our optional <u>Hurghada day tours</u>. Hurghada is where you'll spend the night.

Day 11: Hurghada | Back to Cairo

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Hurghada Airport to catch your flight to Cairo International Airport, where you will have a variety of options for the rest of the day. You can have a Cairo shopping tour at one of the oldest markets in the Middle East, <u>Khan El Khalili</u> Bazaar, which is best known for <u>Islamic Cairo</u> trips, or you can simply have a blissful Nile cruise dinner in Cairo aboard a sailing restaurant while enjoying a unique dance show. An interesting <u>Coptic Cairo</u> tour is also available and can be booked with the assistance of your private tour leader. Overnight in a hotel in Cairo.
