Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival Day: Giza Pyramids and Old Cairo Tour

Your day adventure in Egypt begins with a warm welcome from our tour guide at Cairo International Airport. From there, you'll be transported to the <u>Giza pyramids</u>, where you'll explore these ancient wonders and admire panoramic views.

A visit to one of Egypt's largest Governmental Papyrus Institutes follows, where you can choose handpainted papyrus sheets and witness the fascinating process of papyrus making. Then, immerse yourself in the captivating landmarks and labyrinthine streets of Old Cairo.

Explore <u>the Hanging Church</u>, Ben Ezra Synagogue, Church of St. Barbara, and Church of Abu Serga, among other attractions. Lunch will be provided at an <u>Old Cairo</u> restaurant.

Finally, explore the historic <u>Khan el-Khalili</u> bazaar before returning to your hotel for the night.

Day 2 : Fly to luxor | Luxor Museum & Mummification Museum Tour

After breakfast, your tour guide will be ready to pick you up from the hotel and assist with the checkout process. We will then proceed from Cairo to Luxor, where your hotel awaits for some rest before the excursion commences.

Once you're ready, we will provide transportation from your hotel to the <u>Luxor Museum</u>, which is the country's second most visited museum after the Cairo Egyptian Museum. Unearthed during excavations at the Luxor and Karnak temples, the museum houses a vast collection of artifacts, including jewelry, ceramics, sculptures, and stone tablets. You will visit all the Highlights of Luxor such as the statue of Thutmose III, artwork from the <u>Karnak temple</u>, and Tutankhamun's treasures.

Our next stop is the Mummification Museum, which was guarded by the jackal-headed god Anubis. This museum, which was established in 1997, delves into the intriguing mummification process, including the 70-day ceremony, historical equipment, and the social challenges faced by those involved. After this enlightening history lesson, we will transport you back to your hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 3: Luxor West Bank Tour

After breakfast, our tour guide will pick you up and transport you to Luxor's West Bank to begin the day's activities. Your journey through Egypt will begin in <u>the Valley of the Kings</u>, Thebes' Necropolis. It is located on Luxor's Western Bank. Visitors to Luxor should not miss out on seeing this well-known necropolis. This area consists of tombs beneath Thebes Mountain. Visitors can examine tombs from three different dynasties. Your Egyptologist tour guide may be able to recommend the best tombs to visit. After your tour of the tombs, you'll be taken to the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u>. You will visit the Colossi of Memnon, which are Egypt's two greatest ancient sculptures. After lunch, you will be transported back to your lodging.

Day 4: Tour to Edfu and Kom Ombo from Luxor

Today, after breakfast, we'll visit <u>Kom Ombo</u> and Edfu. You will visit the Temple of Kom Ombo, which was dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek. You come to a halt here before moving on to Edfu. You will be taken to see the falcon-headed divinity at <u>the Temple of Horus</u>. This pharaonic temple has been meticulously preserved and is therefore quite stunning. We'll take you to your hotel in Aswan in the evening so you can check in and possibly spend the night.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 5: Tour to Aswan High Dam and Abu Simbel Temples

Join our exploration after breakfast as our tour guide picks you up from your hotel. Explore the renowned Aswan <u>High Dam</u>, which is a significant embankment dam that crosses the Nile in Aswan. Its construction became a priority after the 1952 Egyptian Revolution due to its benefits in electricity generation, water storage, and flood management.

Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant and then travel to <u>Abu Simbel</u> in an air-conditioned minivan. Marvel at the exceptional architecture of the Abu Simbel temples, which are known as remarkable examples of ancient Egypt's grandeur. Admire these wonderful temples, which were dedicated to Ptah, Re-Her-Akhtey, Amun-Re, and Ramses II.

After spending approximately three hours there, return to your Aswan accommodation for the evening.

Day 6: Visit Philae Temple | Fly to Cairo

Check out after breakfast, and our tour guide will take you up to visit this ancient temple. The <u>Philae</u> <u>Temple</u> is one of Egypt's most stunning temple complexes. Visit the remnants near the former Aswan Dam, and then take a felucca ride to Aglika Island. When the High Dam threatened to submerge the temple permanently, it was moved to its present location. The complex was meticulously rebuilt in its current location, preserving its original design and architecture. Even the vegetation on the island was intended to resemble the complex's previous appearance. When your trip is complete, you will be transported to <u>Aswan Airport</u> to catch your flight to Cairo. When you arrive, arrange transportation to your Cairo hotel.

Day 7: Bahariya Oasis safari Tour

As the first stop on our <u>Bahariya Oasis Tour</u>, our tour guide takes us from Cairo to the Bahariya Oasis. After strolling through the ancient hamlet, traveling to the Black Mountains, and stopping at the salt lake, your Oasis Tour will continue with visits to the famed Mummies Hall, The Golden Mummies, and <u>Ain El Muftella's</u> temple. Your English-speaking tour guide will lead your Oasis Tour, which will be finished with transportation back to your Cairo hotel in the evening.

Day 8: Alexandria Day Tour

Join our tour guide after breakfast as they pick you up to explore the renowned Greco-Roman remains of Alexandria. Explore the intriguing Serapeum, home to <u>Pompey's Pillar</u>, which is a magnificent red granite column. Don't miss the eerie <u>Kom el Shoqafa Catacombs</u> with its surrounding mosaics and well-preserved Roman amphitheater.

Indulge in a delightful Mediterranean seafood feast by the waterfront. Next, you will visit <u>the Citadel</u> <u>of Qaitbay</u>, which is a 15th-century maritime fort that stands on the historic site of the Lighthouse of Alexandria. Immerse yourself in the ancient world at <u>the National Museum of Alexandria</u>, which is known for its captivating underwater archaeological displays.

Experience an enticing street food tour, where you'll savor a variety of Egyptian cuisine influenced by Ottoman and Arab traditions. Delight in kebabs, mixed grills, meze dips, shellfish, and the spicy lentil and noodle dish known as koshary. You will finish the tour with tantalizing ice cream and desserts.

Finally, our driver will transport you to your Alexandria hotel, where you can check in and enjoy a comfortable overnight stay.

Day 9: Alexandria Magic | Back cairo

After breakfast and check-out, our tour guide will drive you up to the site in the morning. Throughout most of antiquity, the <u>Great Library of Alexandria</u> served as a center of learning. First thing in the morning, visit the magnificent Alexandrian Library replica. Alexandria's most well-known mosques are those of Nabi Daniel and Abu al-Abbas al-Mursi.

Continue riding along the corniche after passing the Stanley Bridge and <u>Montazah Palace Gardens</u>. We will travel to Cairo and spend the night after dropping you off at your hotel in the evening.
