Itinerary

Day 1: Tour to Fayoum Oasis

After breakfast, we will pick you up from your hotel in Cairo to visit Tunis Village, which is located across from the beautiful <u>Lake Qarun</u>. This lake is an ideal starting point for your countryside excursion. We will transport you to Fayuom in a modern, air-conditioned vehicle. A tour of the hamlet provides a glimpse into Egyptian agricultural life, as well as the area's renowned pottery studios and schools, as well as a few

businesses that offer desert safari excursions to the area's breathtaking landscapes.

Beautiful Lake Qarun, which stretches for miles along the main road near <u>Tunis Village</u>, is a must-see in Fayoum. Every time you see a boat, you can expect to be given a ride. The tranquil waves will ensure you have a tranquil experience as they softly rock you up and down.

After that, go to one of the few safari shops scattered throughout Tunis Village and ask to be taken to Magic Lake. It's fantastic to see this magnificent lake, which is hidden behind vast dunes and changes color depending on the time of day and year.

The off-roading experience is undoubtedly thrilling; to get there, your tour leader will pick you into a grumbling 44 and transfer you 45 minutes into the desert.

When you arrive at the lake, they will serve you a delicious meal, unpack some blankets and Bedouin tea, and strap you into the <u>sandboard</u>. Next, take a Felucca to <u>Wadi Al Rayan</u>, Egypt's largest natural oasis, where you can explore and photograph stunning scenery.

After that, we'll take you to your hotel in Fayoum, where you can relax and spend the night.

Day 2: Tour in El Fayoum - Going back to cairo

Following breakfast, you will be picked up by our tour guide and taken to <u>Wadi El Hitan</u>, also known as the "Valley of the Whales," which is a breathtaking UNESCO World Heritage site that was once a lake and is now home to coastal marine species that have existed for millions of years. Preserved whale fossils can be found here, demonstrating the mammal's transition from terrestrial to marine species. It is worthwhile to visit this magnificent location. We'll eat lunch at a nearby restaurant.

Then we will go there. We then proceed to the Kom Aushim Museum, which is an excellent place to get guides for the rest of Fayoum. The Museum was originally built in 1974. It includes artifacts from the Prehistoric to Roman eras, as well as a portrait of Fayoum.

The following stop <u>Karanis</u> (The Lord's Town) is one of Fayoum's largest Greco-Roman settlements. Originally settled in the third century B.C. by mercenaries from Ptolemy the Second's army. There are two temples in the city. We will then return you to your Cairo Hotel.
