Day 1: Easter arrival in Cairo

At Cairo International Airport, your English-speaking tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will greet and assist you. He will then drive you in a luxurious, air-conditioned limousine to your hotel.

A welcome drink will be provided to you when you arrive at the hotel, and one of our representatives will help you check in without incident. They will also go through your itinerary with you to confirm the pick-up times for each tour on your Cairo Short Break on the Easter tour.

Day 2: Visit to the Pyramids and Sakkara

After enjoying your breakfast at your Cairo hotel, meet your tour guide to begin your breathtaking Cairo Day Tours.

One of the three pyramids at Giza, the Great Pyramid of Cheops, was finished around about 2560 BCE, and you'll be visiting it. Along with the Pyramids of Chefred and Mykerinus and their guardian, the Great Sphinx, it is among the largest and most spectacular pyramids.

Then you'll travel to Saqqara to see the Step Pyramid Complex, which is thought to be the oldest stone structure in the world and was built by the renowned architect Imhotep for King Djoser. To get a picture of daily life in ancient Egypt with all its activities inscribed and painted on the walls and corridors of those 4000 year old tombs, you will also see the Teti pyramid within and the noble tombs at Sakkara.

To spend the night there, you will be returned to your hotel.

Day 3: Tours of Cairo

On Day 3 of your Cairo tour, after breakfast at the hotel, your Egyptologist tour guide will accompany you to the Egyptian Museum. Here, you'll find the largest collection of Egyptian antiquities in the world, including the famous treasures of Tutankhamen.

Next, your personal guide and driver will take you to the Citadel of Saladin, where you can explore the impressive Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque and enjoy a panoramic view of Islamic Cairo, with its ancient mosques, minarets, and domes that date back hundreds and even thousands of years.

The tour continues to Coptic Cairo, where you'll visit the Roman fortress of Babylon, the Hanging Church, and the church of St. Sergius.

You'll also have the opportunity to visit Ben Ezra Synagogue, which is believed to be the site of the pharaoh's palace where Moses was found in a basket in the Nile. Afterwards, enjoy a delicious lunch before heading to

explore Islamic Cairo.

Discover the walls, gates, and old streets of this medieval city, which date back to the 10th century.

The walk concludes with a refreshing cup of tea at Fishawy, one of the famous and historic cafes located in Khan El Khalili, Cairo's old bazaar.

Return to your hotel for overnight stay in Cairo.
