Itinerary

Day 1: Cairo-Alamein WWII Cemetery and Museum-Siwa

At six in the morning, Cairo Top Tours guide will pick you up at your hotel to start your Egypt Desert Safari Tours. You will then drive for about three hours, stopping for coffee breaks, to Alamein on Egypt's North Coast, where you will enjoy an educational tour that includes visiting the Museum of World War II, learning about the two main battles that took place there and the numbers of armies that participated in the chaos that left a large number of soldiers dead, wounded, and lost when they were still young.

Take a tour of the Commonwealth Cemetery and show your respect for the people who gave their lives for you. During your Al Alamein tours, you will have the opportunity to visit the Australian, Italian, and German memorial cemeteries. After another two hours of driving, you will have an oriental lunch at a reputable restaurant in Marsa Matrouh, After that, we will head to Siwa Oasis, where you will check into your ecolodge, rest, and, if we have time, take a dip in one of the natural hot springs to unwind after a tiring day of driving.

Day 2: Siwa Sightseeing Tours

After enjoying a traditional Egyptian breakfast at your hotel, begin your Egypt Travel Packages by touring the old town of Shali in the city centre with our tour guide. The Shali Fortress was constructed using the kerchief method, which involves combining clay, salt, and mud. These locally available materials have been used by the Siwan people for centuries to keep the interiors of their buildings and homes cooler. Regretfully, some of the 13th-century fortress's walls collapsed due to heavy rai.

Make your way to the Temple of Alexander the Great, also called the Temple of the Oracle of Amun, which is the most significant location in Siwa. Proceed to observe the remnants of the Amun Temple located in Um Ubayda, which honours the trio of Amun, Mut, and Khonso. The governor of Siwa blew because the temple was destroyed.

in 1869 in order to construct a large palace and a presidential rest stop. The <u>Siwan House</u> was constructed by the Siwan people as a way for them to participate in preventing the loss of their cultural legacy. Now is the perfect opportunity to learn more about the Siwan people's daily tools and accessories, customs, and culture. Enjoy your lunch in a good quality restaurant then have a relaxing afternoon at <u>Cleopatra Spring</u> known as Ein Guba

Day 3: Great Siwa Mountain - Great Sand Sea Safari - Bir Wahed Hot Spring

After having a satisfying breakfast at the Eco-lodge, begin your Siwa Oasis Desert Safari by stopping at Maraki Village to explore the remarkable archaeological site atop Great Siwa Mountain, which is home to the oldest known human footprint discovered, which dates back to the prehistoric period. Continue our tour between the dunes until we reach the fossil area, where we can observe the Cambrian-era rocky coral reefs.

Drive to one of the most fascinating locations in the world's third-largest sand mass, the Great Sand Sea, for an incredibly thrilling Jeep Safari experience. Stop at a stunning lake in the middle of the desert for a chance to swim with the amiable Tilapia fish. Then, enjoy the exhilarating experience of sandboarding. It's time to take a shower in the hot spring known as Bir Wahid, which is one of the main leisure activities in Siwa. Sip lemon-leaf Bedouin tea and take in another captivating Sun Set at the Great Sand Sea in the middle of the dunes.

Spend the night in Siwa.

Day 4: Siwa Oasis Tour

Start your tour to the rock-cut tombs at the <u>Mountain of the Dead</u> (Gabal El Mauta) after eating breakfast at the Eco-lodge. See the impressive tombs of the rulers of Siwa Oasis during the 26th dynasty, such as the tomb of SI Amon and another tomb known as the Crocodile Tomb, which is named after the well-preserved crocodile painting found inside.

Next, take a tour of the Bedouin Village of Abu Ali to experience the Bedouin way of life and take in the views of the mountains that resemble canyons and the silence that permeates the area. Return to Siwa to see the well-known <u>Dakrour Mountain</u>, the site of the Siwan people's yearly tourism festival held on the first full moon of October at Siwa Oasis (El Syaha). After creating your own timelapse photos and taking in yet another breathtaking sunset view from the enchanted Fitnas Island, you'll be taken back to the city centre to spend the night in your eco-lodge.

Day 5: Siwa-Cairo

After breakfast, make the transfer from Siwa to Cairo, where you will check into your hotel for the night before leaving for the Bahariya Oasis tour early the next morning.

Day 6: Cairo to Bahariya Oasis and White Desert

Proceed to the <u>Bahariya Oasis</u>, early in the morning from Cairo. Lunch will be served to you while travelling to Bahariya. You will drive a 4WD Jeep up Black Mountain at dusk to explore the English House ruins and enjoy a breathtaking view of Salt Lake and the entire Oasis, which are encircled by verdant date palm forests. When we visit the <u>Museum of the Golden Mummies</u>, we can infer from its name that the mummies within are made of gold, were produced in Egypt during the Greco-Roman era, and are composed of the mummies of the ancient Egyptian pharaohs.

After that, you will visit The Tombs of Nobles at Qasr Sleem, which include the rock-cut tombs of Zed-Amun-Ef-Ankh and Bannentiu, and the Temple of Ain El Muftella, which is dedicated to the ancient Egyptian god Bis, who was considered the god of joy and entertainment in Egyptian religion. Additionally, we will travel to the White Desert, passing through the Black Desert, which is a region of mountains shaped like volcanoes with a large number of small black stones, and the Valley of El Haize, the southernmost village of Bahriya Oasis with its delightful spring.

One of the amazing sights we can see when travelling to Egypt is the quartz crystal at <u>Crystal Mountain</u> and the stunning Valley of Agabat. Overnight camping in the <u>White Desert</u> gives you the opportunity to take in the breathtaking sunset view while your guides prepare your dinner.

Day 7: Back to Cairo

You will eat breakfast at the campsite the next day and then head to the hot spring to take a bath, unwind, and take in the gorgeous, serene water. After that, take a car back to Bahariya, and from there, travel to Cairo.
