Day 2: Kasr Ibrim/ Amada Temple/ Derr Temple/ Wadi El Seboua

The temples of Wadi El Sebou were dismantled and relocated to a higher site when Lake Nasser's water level started to rise following the construction of the Aswan High Dam.

You will be transferred back to the Prince Abbas Nasser Lake Tour where your trip to Aswan will start after your visit to the temple. You will receive your lunch and have afternoon tea. You will eat your dinner on board and spend the night in Aswan on board.

Day 4: Sightseeing Tour and Disembarkation in Aswan
