Itinerary

Day 1: Friday - Embarkation - Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

When you arrive, our representative will welcome and help you, and before lunch, you will be escorted to boarding. After a delectable lunch on the MS Royal Princess Nile Cruise, you will be taken to begin your Egypt Classic tours from Australia with a visit to the well-known high dam in Aswan. This structure is approximately 4,000 meters long and 980 meters wide at the base, and it holds 43,000,000 cubic meters of materials. Surprisingly, 11,000 cubic meters of water can pass through the dam per second through 180 sluice gates, which control the flow of water to prevent flooding.

During <u>Aswan day tours</u>, you will be taken to the granite quarries where the ancient Egyptians obtained the necessary building blocks for their magnificent pyramids and temples. There, you will witness the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, which is thought to have been carved during the reign of the formidable Queen Hatshepsut, who established the new kingdom of ancient Egypt.

After a full day in Aswan, your driver and guide will take you to see one of the greatest works of art in <u>ancient Egypt</u>, the <u>Temple of Philae</u> or the Goddess Isis Temple. Next, you will sail down the Nile and enjoy afternoon tea before being greeted with a welcome cocktail from the captain.

You will spend the night in Aswan after dinner on your Egypt Nile River Cruise while taking in a breathtaking Nubian show.

Meals Included: Lunch and Dinner

Day 2: Saturday - Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

You will begin your tour to Kom Ombo and Edfu on your second day, after breakfast on board your Egypt Nile River Cruise. Kom Ombo is an unusual double temple located in the town of Kom Ombo in the Aswan Governorate, Upper Egypt. Built between 180 and 47 BC, it was part of the Ptolemaic dynasty. After exploring the incredible Kom Ombo Temple, which is shared by the crocodile-shaped god Sobek and the well-known Haroeris, you will sail to Edfu and have lunch on your Luxury Nile cruise from Aswan to Luxor. Later, during the Roman era, some additions were made to this temple.

Next, you will be escorted to see the <u>Edfu Temple</u>, which dates back to the Ptolemaic era and was constructed between 237 and 57 B.C.

Horus, the god with a falcon's head, was the object of devotion at the Edfu temple. The great myth involving the gods Horus and Seth is said to have taken place at the location of the temple, according to ancient Egyptian interpretations. Following your sail to Esna to attend an Egyptian Galabeya Party, you will be served dinner on board the cruise ship. In Egypt, a "Galabeya" is a one-piece long dress worn by both men and women. In Esna, you'll stay the night. Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are Included.

Day 3: Sunday - Luxor East Bank Tours

You will enjoy your third day's activities as follows:

Breakfast on the Nile cruise boat, lunch on the Nile cruise from Aswan to Luxor, sailing to Luxor via the Esna lock to enjoy <u>Luxor day tours</u>, and afternoon tea to help you unwind after your tour to see the <u>Luxor Temple</u>. the outer courtyard, known as the courtyard of <u>Ramesses II</u>, was constructed during the reign of the great builder and military conqueror Amenophis the Third. You will visit the <u>Karnak Temple</u> following dinner on board the 4-wheel drive vehicle. It is 57 meters (188 feet) long and 51 meters (168 feet) wide. You will enjoy a belly dance show during your four-day Nile River Cruise from Aswan to Luxor after dinner. You will spend the night in Luxor.

Day 4: Monday - Disembarkation - Luxor West Bank Tours

After breakfast on board, you will check out of the Egypt Nile River Cruise and begin your Luxor West Bank Tours. Once you have chosen three tombs to see inside the <u>Valley of the Kings</u> and visited the magnificent <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u> (El-Deir El-Bahari Temple), you will be transferred to continue your Luxor excursions to the Valley of the Kings, which is home to the tomb of Ramses III, one of the largest and most visited tombs in the Valley of the Kings. El-Deir El-Bahari, the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, is the first undiscovered tomb since Tutankhamun's tomb was found.

You will eventually pause to see the Colossal of Memnon.
