You will also visit some of the most popular temples in Egypt such as the Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples in Luxor, the Philae Temple, the High Dam, and the unfinished Obelisk in Aswan.

Itinerary

Day 1: Embarkation / Luxor East Bank Tours

Your representative will pick you up at your Luxor hotel and take you on your 5-day Nile Cruise Tour from Luxor to Aswan, Our guide will give you the keys to your cabin, and then you will have a short break and enjoy your first lunch on board the MS Royal Viking Nile Cruise or a similar cruise.

Your English-speaking Egyptologist tour guide will then meet you in the lobby to start your <u>Luxor East Bank Tours</u>.

Next, you will visit the <u>Karnak Temple</u>, which was built and expanded over 2,000 years from a small shrine during the New Kingdom to become a huge temple and the largest temple in Egypt. Then, after your visit to Karnak, you will be transferred to the wonderful <u>Luxor Temple</u>. The Luxor Temple is one of the most impressive tourist attractions not just in Luxor but throughout all of Egypt.

You can also book an optional <u>sound and light show</u> at the temple of Karnak.

Day 2: Luxor West bank Tours

You will meet your tour guide after a delicious breakfast on board the MS Royal Viking Nile Cruise to start your tour to the West Bank in Luxor with a visit to the Valley of the Kings, which is one of the most beautiful sites in Luxor, containing the royal tombs of our great kings. The first king to be buried there was King Tutmosis I from the 18th Dynasty.

Then you continue your Luxor West Bank tour by visiting the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u>, which is also known as the Temple of El Deir El Bahari in modern times. After that, you will see the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, and these are two incredibly large statues of the Pharaoh Amenhotep III.

After finishing the Visit Your tasty lunch will be served aboard the Luxor to Aswan Nile Cruise, and then you will enjoy sailing to Edfu. Your delicious dinner will be served in the evening, and you'll spend the night on the Nile Cruise in Edfu.

(Optional <u>Luxor Hot Air Balloon Ride</u> above the west bank monuments).

Day 3: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

After enjoying the previous two days of Luxor sightseeing tours, you will now take pleasure in a delicious breakfast on board the Nile Cruise, and you will be joined by your knowledgeable tour guide to make one of the most fascinating stops possible.

The journey begins with a visit to Edfu to see the <u>Temple of Edfu</u>, which is one of the largest in Egypt (the largest after the Karnak Temple) and one of the best-preserved in the country. Then you will get back to the cruise ship to enjoy an enchanting sailing time to the south until you reach Kom Ombo.

Next, you will visit the Kom Ombo Temple, which was built between 1350 and 180 BC. It was built by

order of King Ramesses II.

After completing your tour in Kom Ombo and Edfu, the boat will sail towards Aswan. You will enjoy a delicious dinner, entertainment, and local music on the cruise.

Day 4: Aswan Sightseeing Tour

You will have breakfast on your Egypt Nile cruise before meeting your private tour guide for your Aswan Excursions. Here is an overview of the activities:

First, You will visit the <u>High Dam</u>, which was constructed to protect Egypt from the annual floods of the Nile River. This important structure has prevented the wastage of water and the flooding of Egypt. Aswan, the southernmost city in Egypt, is located near the first Nile waterfall, approximately one thousand kilometers away from Cairo.

Next, you will visit The <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u> granite quarries where ancient Egyptians used to cut and transport granite for the construction of the great pyramids, temples, pillars, and obelisks during the Old Kingdom of Egypt. One of the most notable attractions in Egypt is the Unfinished Obelisk, showcasing the craftsmanship and engineering techniques of ancient Egyptians.

Following that you will visit the <u>Philae Temple</u>, which was built in the Greco-Roman style. This temple was dedicated to the worship of the goddess Isis and is one of the four sites associated with the legend of Isis, Osiris, and Horus.

After the temple visit, you will be transferred back to the cruise ship to enjoy a delicious lunch. The afternoon will be free for you to explore Aswan at your leisure. In the evening, a high-quality dinner will be prepared and served on the cruise boat. You will also have the opportunity to watch an interesting Nubian show. Overnight accommodation will be provided in Aswan.

Day 5: Disembarkation/ End of our 5 Day Nile Cruise Tour from Luxor to Aswan
