Itinerary

Day 1: Wednesday - Embarkation - Aswan Nile Cruise

You will board MY Alexander the Great Nile Cruise and check in before lunch after being greeted and assisted by our friendly and experienced tour manager upon your arrival. When you finish your lunch on your luxurious Nile cruise from Aswan to Luxor, you will be taken on an Aswan to see the High Dam, which at the time of its construction produced about half of Egypt's electricity, and the Philae Temple, which was one of the last locations in which the ancient Egyptian religion of the goddess Isis was practiced following the spread of Christianity in Egypt, enjoy an afternoon tea followed by the captain's welcome cocktail. You will also go on Aswan excursions to the granite quarries to see the Unfinished Obelisk of Queen Hatshepsut and sail on the Nile by motorboat, which is a novel and exciting experience. As you watch a Nubian show, you'll eat a delicious lunch on the cruise ship. Spend the night in Aswan. Meals included on board: lunch and dinner

Day 2: Thursday - Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

After enjoying breakfast on the cruise ship, you will sail to <u>Kom Ombo</u> and begin your second tour by exploring the temple shared by the gods Sobek and Haroeris in Kom Ombo. Next, you will sail to Edfu and, after lunch on the Nile cruise ship, you will be escorted to see the <u>Edfu Temple</u>, which was constructed for the worship of <u>God Horus</u>, the son of Osiris and Isis and, according to ancient Egyptian religion, one of the most powerful and important gods of ancient Egypt.

Once your tour of Edfu is over, you can enjoy a leisurely and tranquil lunch while taking in the scenery. After that, you sail to Esna to take part in an oriental Galapagos party. staying in Esna for the night Included Onboard Meals: Dinner, Lunch, and Breakfast

Day 3: Friday - Luxor East Bank Tours

After a delicious breakfast, you will set sail for Luxor via the Esna. Lunch will be served on board the cruise ship, and you will then enjoy a delightful afternoon tea before beginning your Egypt classic tours from Australia in Luxor. During your Luxor day tours, you will be escorted to see the Luxor Temple, a sizable complex of ancient Egyptian temples built by the monarchs of the New Kingdom. Typically, Luxor East Bank Tours visit this site, which is located in the city now known as Luxor (ancient Thebes), and dates back to around 1400 B.C. Next, proceed to the Karnak Temple. It is referred to as "the southern sanctuary" in the language of the ancient Egyptians, ipet resyt, Savoring dinner on the cruise ship while taking in a belly dance performance will be enjoyable.

Day 4: Saturday - Disembarkation - Luxor West Bank Tours
