Itinerary

Day 1: Friday - Embarkation - Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

When you arrive, our tour guide will meet and assist you. Before lunch, he will assist you in boarding your 5-star MS Movenpick Royal Lily Nile Cruise, which offers the largest <u>Aswan day tours</u>. Begin your Egypt Day Tours, and in particular your Aswan Excursions, with a visit to the magnificent <u>High Dam</u>, constructed in the 1960s to provide Egypt with electricity and protect the nation from Nile floods. Continue your excursions in Aswan by touring the stunning <u>Temple of Philae</u>, which was constructed for the worship of Goddess Isis, the Egyptian goddess of magic and Osiris's wife, and taking a motorboat ride down the Nile.

After the entertainment show, have dinner served on board the Aswan to Luxor Nile Cruise boat, and spend the night there after lunch. Savor a delightful afternoon tea while taking in the beauty of the Aswan Nile River.

Day 2: Saturday - Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

Breakfast on the Nile cruise boat while sailing to Kom Ombo and Edfu, and visit the temple of Kom Ombo, which was shared by the two gods of ancient Egypt, <u>Sobek</u>, and Haroeris. Sail to Edfu and enjoy an open-buffet lunch before visiting <u>Edfu Temple</u>, one of the largest temples in Upper Egypt built for the God of the Sky, <u>Horus</u>, who was represented by a falcon. Dinner is served aboard the cruise ship while sailing to Esna and enjoying the Egyptian Galabeya Party. Overnight in Esna

Day 3: Sunday - Luxor East Bank Tours

Breakfast will be served aboard your ship while sailing to Luxor via Esna lock and admiring the beautiful views of the Nile River, followed by lunch and afternoon tea. The Luxor Temple was built between 1400 and 1000 BC by the pharaohs Amenhotep III and Ramses II.

After your Luxor East Bank Tours, proceed to the magnificent Karnak Temple, which is home to the magnificent Amun Temple as well as several smaller temples, chapels, and a large sacred lake.

Queen Hatshepsut, Seti I, Ramses II, and Ramses III were the most well-known pharaohs who worked on its construction. The belly dance show and dinner were highlights of the Nile cruise in Luxor. In Luxor for the night

Day 4: Monday - Disembarkation - Luxor West Bank Tours

After breakfast on the Nile cruise ship and check-out, you'll begin the <u>Luxor West Bank Tours</u> with the assistance of your knowledgeable guide. Visit the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, Egypt's necropolis where a large number of the pharaohs of the <u>newly formed kingdom</u> are interred; to date, more than 60 tombs carved out of the rocks have been found. Continue your Luxor excursions to see the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut. Excavated on the precipitous limestone cliffs that rise above the desert in the Deir el-Bahari valley, the Hatshepsut Temple is a remarkable structure that never fails to astound visitors on Luxor sightseeing tours. Transfer to the railroad or airport in Luxor.
