Itinerary

Day 1: Embarkation in Aswan

A tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will be there to greet you when you land in Egypt, holding a signboard with your name on it, at [the Aswan Airport](#) or the Train Station.

Your private, air-conditioned, non-smoking vehicle will take you to the dock where your Aswan to Luxor Nile cruise starts. You'll realize every wish you ever had on this enchanted Nile River cruise. In addition to providing a picturesque view, [the High Dam](#), which is regarded as the most significant project in Egypt's modern history, protected the nation from the Nile River's frequent floods.

You will visit The unfinished obelisk, which is the famous Granite Quarries, where the ancient Egyptians mined the stones that they used to build the enormous pyramids of Egypt and the enormous temples of the new kingdom, are the next stop on your Aswan day tour. Explore [The Unfinished Obelisk](#) next, which is an illustration of how they used huge stones to create memorial structures, as we see on Egypt tours. Finally, Visit the Isis Temple on a motorboat, a Greco-Roman architectural masterpiece allegedly setting the Osiris and Seth myth. Enjoy a delicious dinner onboard the cruise ship, followed by an entertaining Nubian folkloric show.

Day 2: Luxor Sightseeing Tours

After you finish breakfast on board your Egypt Nile River Cruise, you will start your tour to Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples, which is one of the most incredible Day Tours in Egypt. The boat will head north to [the Kom Ombo Temple](#). Our next stop will be the Ptolemaic Temple of God Sobek, which was a place of worship for the god Haroeris, who was a god of heaven. After everyone has had enough time to explore the temple, your boat will set sail for Edfu and your delicious buffet lunch will be served.

After reaching [Edfu Temple](#), you'll take a carriage to the historic Horus Temple before boarding a boat and sailing to Esna while taking afternoon tea. In the evening, a second fantastic dinner will be served on board. Once you've finished your tour of Edfu, you'll spend the night on your Nile cruise in Esna, where the entertainment will be an absolutely incredible Egyptian Galabeya Party.

Breakfast, lunch, dinner, and afternoon tea are all included.

Day 3: Tour to the West Bank of Luxor

Take pleasure in a satisfying breakfast as the boat travels towards Luxor, and then get ready for the West Bank of Luxor Tours, which is widely regarded as the city's top attraction.

You will disembark when you get to Luxor and start your Luxor day tours there. Explore the Valley of the Kings, which is famous for the rock-cut tombs where many New Kingdom pharaohs were buried, such as Ramses the Great and Tutankhamun. One of the most successful excavations in Egyptian history can be seen in the fact that Tutankhamun's tomb was found in its entirety in 1922. After that, you'll explore Luxor's famous [Temple of Hatshepsut](#), which is a magnificent structure. Before enjoying a delightful onboard lunch, your tour will come to an end when you see the historic Colossi of Memnon, which was constructed for King Amenhotep III.
