Day 1: Friday - Embarkation - Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

After being met by our tour guide at [Luxor International Airport](#), we will walk you through the Egypt Nile River Cruise's embarkation procedures before lunch is served on board. On your [Aswan Day Tour](#), you will meet your Egyptologist guide and visit Egypt's High Dam, which was built to generate electricity and protect the nation from catastrophic flooding. Get back to learning about the myth of Isis and Osiris by continuing your Aswan excursions and stopping by the [Temple of Philae](#), which was constructed in honor of Isis, the Goddess of Love and Magic and, in ancient Egyptian mythology, the wife of Osiris.

After that, return to the cruise ship cruising [the Nile River](#). In the afternoon, enjoy tea on the upper deck with the captain and a welcome drink. A local Nubian band will entertain you with an interesting Nubian show after your delicious dinner buffet is served on board. After which you will spend the night in Aswan.

Day 2: Saturday - Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

Once you've finished your excursions in Aswan for the day, enjoy breakfast on board the cruise ship. Your Egypt Nile River Cruises will then set sail for Kom Ombo, where you'll be met by a knowledgeable guide to begin your incredible tour of Kom Ombo and Edfu. You'll get off the boat to explore the temple in [Kom Ombo](#) that is shared by the gods Sobek and Haeroris, and then the boat will sail to Edfu while lunch is served on board.

Visit the Edfu Temple in the afternoon, which is devoted to the god Horus. This is the temple where he annually met his lovely wife, [the goddess Hathor](#), and it has been buried beneath more than 12 meters of desert sand for many years, keeping it almost entirely intact. As you sail to Esna on the Nile cruise ship, dinner will be served. After the Egyptian Galabeya Party, you will spend the night in [Esna](#).

Day 3: Sunday - Luxor West Bank Tours

On the Sonesta St. George Nile cruise, enjoy breakfast while sailing to Luxor early in the morning. The magnificent [Luxor West Bank Tours](#) offers day trips to Luxor that begin with a visit to [the Valley of the Kings](#), where 62 kings and rulers of the new kingdom of ancient Egypt rest in peace. The artisans and laborers who worked in this region once lived in the nearby village of Deir Al-Madina. Other Luxor excursions include a visit to the [Temple of Queen Hatshepsut](#) at El-Deir El Bahari, which was constructed for the female ruler who succeeded her father Thutmose I, and the Colossi of Memnon.

the two enormous, colossal statues of [Amenhotep III](#) in the location of his former great temple. A belly dancing show will take place at night to cap off an action-packed day of fun and adventure. Lunch will be served on the boat and afternoon tea will be served prior to dinner.

Day 4: Monday - Disembarkation - Luxor East Bank Tours

Following breakfast on board the Nile cruise ship, you will disembark from your Egypt Nile River Cruise. Commence your Luxor East Bank Tours by visiting the [Karnak Temple](#), one of Egypt's largest temples that served as the administrative and religious hub when Egypt first arrived in Mesopotamia, and the temple that is connected to Karnak Temple via the Avenue of the Sphinxes. Luxury Built by Amenemph III, the [Luxor Temples](#) are a must-see stop for sightseeing tours. After your visit, you'll be taken to the Luxor Train/Airport Station for your departure.
