Day 1: Saturday - Embarkation Luxor East Bank Tours

We will pick you up from any point in Luxor, such as the train station or Luxor International Airport, and the first day will be spent checking into your cozy cabin on the Sonesta Moon Goddess Nile Cruise before lunch. Then, enjoy your [Luxor day tours](#) with your Egyptologist guide as you see the magnificent [Karnak Temple](#), which is regarded as the crown jewel of the ancient Egyptian monuments constructed primarily during the New Kingdom. He will also lead you to the renowned [Luxor Temple](#), which was started by Amenhotep the Third and built by a number of kings.

You will continue your Luxor East Bank Tours and then take in the afternoon tea and belly dancing show before dinner is served on board. You can also relax and listen to music in the lounge.

Meals: Lunch, Dinner

Day 2: Sunday - Luxor West Bank Tours - Sail o Edfu

See the stunning city of Luxor from above by taking an optional hot air balloon ride in the early morning. You will receive an early morning wake-up call, eat breakfast on board your Egypt Nile River Cruise, and then begin your [Egypt luxury tours from Australia](#) in Luxor by visiting the Luxor West Bank Tours, where you will learn about mummification, and the various Egyptian burial customs, as well as witness the final stages of the royal tombs, which were carved into the western mountain that would later be known as the [Valley of the Kings](#) by the Pharaohs of the new kingdom.

Proceed with your Luxor excursions as your guide shows you the [Colossi of Memnon](#) and the Queen [Hatshepsut Temple](#), the home of the renowned female Pharaoh of ancient Egypt. After lunch on board and an afternoon tea, set sail for Edfu. Supper is served in the lounge while music is played.

Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner Meals

Day 3: Monday - Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples - Sail to Aswan

A delicious breakfast and an early wake-up call await you on the cruise ship. After a fantastic tour of Edfu and Kom Ombo, where you can see the [Edfu Temple](#), which was constructed for the worship of the god Horus, you sail to Kom Ombo while lunch is served on board. Enjoy a fascinating tour of the [Kom Ombo Temple](#), which was once home to the [gods Sobek](#) and Horaeris. Then, continue sailing towards Aswan while savoring a delectable afternoon tea and dinner aboard. The Galabiya Party will take place as part of Cairo Top Tours' entertainment program.

Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner Meals

Day 4: Tuesday - Aswan Tours

You will have breakfast on board the boat at seven in the morning before disembarking from your Egypt Nile River Cruise and beginning your [Aswan day tours](#). You will explore the High Dam, which is the largest dam in Egypt, albeit not the first. After that, you will go to the Granite Quarries to see the largest [Unfinished Obelisk](#), which, contrary to what some scholars claim, was never completed before Queen Hatshepsut died. The [Temple of Philae](#) in Aswan, which was built in the Greco-Roman architectural style for the worship of Goddess Isis, will be your next stop on your Aswan excursions.

Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner Meals

Day 5: Wednesday - Check-out O

Our tour leader will transport you to the [Aswan Airport](#) or train, or any other desired drop-off location, following your breakfast on board the Luxor to Aswan Nile Cruise boat.
