Day 1: Monday - Luxor East Bank Tours

When you arrive at <u>Luxor's airport</u> or train station, our tour guide will assist you and transfer you to the MS Mayfair Egypt Nile River Cruise. Before beginning your Luxor East Bank Tours, enjoy a satisfying lunch on board the Nile cruise. The two largest temples in the world, Karnak and Luxor, are the main <u>attractions in Luxor</u>. After having dinner on board, the group will spend the night in Luxor before starting its day tours the following day.

Day 2: Tuesday - Luxor West Bank Tours

The West Bank of Luxor tours are one of the most enjoyable Egypt Day Tours in Luxor, so start your day with a delicious breakfast on the boat and then take advantage of the excellent opportunity to experience a fascinating Hot air balloon ride over Luxor in the early morning. Visit the Valley of the Kings, where numerous influential pharaohs during the New Kingdom were buried. You will see the Colossi of Memnon, which are remnants from an ancient Egyptian temple constructed by Amenophis III and are known by the Greeks by this name, as well as Queen Hatshepsut's Temple of El Deir El Bahari, which is regarded as one of the most well-known mortuary temples. Before afternoon tea and the Captain's Welcome Cocktail Party, a lunch cruise to Esna will be provided. Enjoy your meal and stay the night in Esna.

Day 3: Wednesday - Edfu & Kom Ombo Temples

After finishing breakfast, you will embark on a tour of <u>Edfu</u> and Kom Ombo, two of the largest temples between Luxor and Aswan. The tour to Edfu will begin with a visit to the Temple of Edfu, which features amazing high-tension towers. King Ptolemy VIII is shown defeating his foes in front of <u>the god Horus</u> in battle scenes that can be seen on the temple walls. The columns have decorative lettering on three sides, and they stand in an open courtyard. To reach Kom Ombo, you will sail.

Before beginning the tour to Kom Ombo, you can enjoy your lunch on board and an afternoon cup of tea. At Kom Ombo, you can see the temple's main deity, Sobek, who has a crocodile head and a human body, and pay homage to him. Your Nile River cruise will then depart for Aswan. Spend the night in Aswan and bring your delicious dinner with you.

Day 4: Thursday - Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

On board your MS Mayfair Nile cruise in Aswan, your breakfast buffet will be available in the early morning. You will now begin your Aswan day tours to see the Aswan High Dam: Your tour guide will describe the significance of this enormous project and how it influences Egypt's development.

Obelisk Still Unfinished

Visit the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, which Queen Hatshepsut constructed but has not yet finished, by taking a transfer to the granite quarries. This obelisk was designed to be the biggest one in prehistoric Egypt.

The Philae Temple

After enjoying your lunch on board and afternoon tea, you will visit the <u>Temple of Philae</u>, which was constructed for the worship of the goddess of magic, Isis. While taking in the Nubian Folkloric Show, enjoy a delicious dinner on your Egypt Nile River Cruise.
