Day 1 Thursday: Arrive Luxor - Luxor East Bank Tours

Greetings from Luxor!

When you land in Luxor, a skilled representative from Cairo Top Tours will be waiting to transfer you to the Semiramis II Nile Cruise where your [Luxor East Bank Tours](#) will begin. The most impressive temple ever built for the worship of the Sun God during the New Kingdom Amun Re is [Karnak Temple](#), which has enormous pylons, columns, and a great hypostyle hall. The most significant pharaohs involved in its construction were Hatshepsut, Seti I, Ramses II, and Ramses III. [Luxor Temple](#) is a large temple that was built by many Pharaohs to witness the excellence of ancient Egyptians.

Day 2 Friday: Luxor West Bank Tours - Sail to Edfu

If you asked your private tour guide to make arrangements for you, a morning hot air balloon ride over Luxor would be an optional activity.

After eating your daily breakfast on board your Egypt Nile River Cruise, begin your Luxor day tours by visiting the highlights of Luxor West Bank Tours, like [the Valley of the Kings](#), where most of the New Kingdom pharaohs rest in peace. You'll be impressed by the preservation of colors in the wall paintings, especially the judgment scene where you'll see numerous deities like [God Osiris](#) of the afterlife, Goddess Maat, who was the Goddess of Justice, and others.

At the end of your Luxor excursions, you will tour [the Colossi of Memnon](#), two enormous seated stone statues that represent the pharaoh Amenhotep III and are not in the best of condition. Hatshepsut was the fifth Pharaoh of the 18th Dynasty and the second female Pharaoh to rule Egypt. As you cruise to Edfu, savor your delicious open-buffet lunch and dinner.

Day 3 Saturday: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

Your knowledgeable guide will accompany you as you begin the Kom Ombo and Edfu tour to visit Horus Temple, also known as [Edfu Temple](#) after you have breakfast on the Nile cruise. As the son of Isis and Osiris and the Egyptian god of the skies, Horus was depicted as having a human body and a hawk's head. After that, set sail for Kom Ombo to see its temple, which was built during [the Ptolemaic era](#) and features two entrances: one was dedicated to Haroeris, a falcon-headed god, and the other was built for God Sobek, a crocodile-shaped deity. Sail to Aswan while taking in the breathtaking Nile River scenery.
