Day 1: Monday - Luxor East Bank Tours

Your tour guide from [Cairo Top Tours](#) will meet you at the train station or Luxor Airport with a sign bearing the name of your reservation. Following that, you will board your Amwaj Living Stone Nile Cruise ship via a private, air-conditioned, non-smoking vehicle transfer. After enjoying your on-board lunch, return to your cabin to unwind. Visit the enormous [Karnak Temple](#), which is regarded in ancient Egyptian mythology as the throne of Amun-Re, the Lord of Gods, to begin your [Egypt luxury tours from Australia](#). Through your Luxor tour, you will enjoy afternoon tea, proceed to view the magnificent [Luxor Temple](#), which was constructed remarkably near to the Nile River. After that, take in a two-hour oriental belly dance performance by a professional dancer from the area.

On your delightful Egypt Nile River Cruise, you will be receiving a gourmet dinner before spending the night in Luxor. Lunch and Dinner Meals are included.

Day 2: Tuesday - Luxor West Bank Tours

You will begin your fascinating Luxor West Bank Tours in the early morning after enjoying breakfast on board. Your knowledgeable Egyptologist will accompany you as you explore the [Valley of the Kings](#) and learn about mummification and the New Kingdom's funeral customs. Next, you will visit the magnificent [Queen Hatshepsut's Temple](#), which was built by her loving architect Senmot during the eighteenth dynasty, and the remnants of Amenhotep III Temple, which is located on the west bank of the Nile and later known as the [Colossi of Memnon](#).

Following your excursions around Luxor, your Egypt Nile River Cruise will sail to [Edfu](#). There, you'll enjoy a delicious lunch buffet prepared on board, followed by tea served on the sun deck and a Captain's Welcome Cocktail Party later in the afternoon. Savor your meal while sailing with a breathtaking view of the Nile, and spend the night in Esna.

Day 3: Wednesday - Edfu & Kom Ombo Temples

After enjoying a delicious breakfast on the third day of your MS Amwaj Living Stone Egypt Nile River Cruise, we will begin the fascinating Kom Ombo and Edfu tour with a visit to [Edfu Temple](#), one of the most important ancient Egyptian monuments that dates back to the Ptolemaic Era. To explore [Kom Ombo Temple](#), we're going to sail there. The two parallel temples that make up the construction make it unique. Horus was honored in the northern section, while [Sobek](#), the crocodile god, was honored in the southern section. The two gods are the objects of worship in this temple. Before visiting and setting sail for Aswan, there will be lunch on board the ship and afternoon tea. After dinner, you will spend the night in Aswan on the ship.

Day 4: Thursday - Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

You will enjoy Aswan tours to see the [High Dam](#), the most significant accomplishment in Egypt's modern history, which is situated south of Aswan on the route to the airport, following your delectable breakfast on the Nile Cruise. After that, you and your private tour guide will explore the Granite Quarries area in order to view the largest [unfinished obelisk](#), which was most likely built by the well-known Queen Hatshepsut, who ruled Egypt during the establishment of the new kingdom. The [Temple of Philae](#), which was constructed during the Ptolemaic era and moved to the island of Agilica during a salvage effort in the 1960s to prevent the temple from being inundated by Nile River water, will finally be seen by you aboard a traditional motorboat as we continue your Aswan excursions. The temple was constructed to honor the goddess of magic, Isis, who was the mother of the falcon god Horus. Savor your afternoon tea and lunch aboard.

On board your Amwaj Living Stone Nile Cruise ship, you will enjoy a delectable dinner in the evening along with the Nubian Folkloric Show, which is performed by local Aswani Nubian artists.

Spend the night in Aswan on your opulent Egypt Nile River Cruise.
