You will visit some of the most notable tombs in Egypt such as the temple of the god Sobek in Kom Ombo and the rock-cut temple of Abu Simbel, and you can explore many other attractions through our Egypt Day Tours.

You can enjoy many recreational activities such as the hot air balloon ride over Luxor Cruises, which is held above the largest open-air museum in the world. Itinerary

Day 1: Embarkation in Aswan

When you arrive in Egypt, a tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will be waiting for you at the <u>Aswan</u> <u>Airport</u> or the train station holding a signboard that displays your name.

You will be transported in a private, nonsmoking, air-conditioned vehicle to the dock where your Aswan to Luxor Nile cruise tour begins. This magical cruise along the Nile River will fulfill all of your dreams.

Following boarding and check-in procedures, you will unwind in your cabin before enjoying a delicious open-bar lunch on board and beginning your Aswan sightseeing as follows:

The High Dam, which is regarded as the most important project in Egypt's modern history, protected the country from the Nile River's constant floods besides the charming view of the high dam. The incomplete obelisk

Continue your Aswan day tour by being driven to the well-known Granite Quarries, where the ancient Egyptians mined the stones, which they used to construct the enormous pyramids of Egypt and the enormous temples of the new kingdom. Then, explore <u>The Unfinished Obelisk</u>, which is one of the examples of how they cut enormous stones and used them in memorial structures, as we see on Egypt tours.

Finally, you will visit Isis Temple:

Take the motorboat to the incredible <u>Philae Temple</u>, which was dedicated to the goddess Isis and constructed in the Greco-Roman architectural style. The temple is regarded as one of the sites where the myth of Osiris and Seth took place.

After finishing Aswan Excursions in the evening, enjoy a lovely dinner aboard the cruise ship, and then you will relish the entertainment and the special Nubian folkloric show.

Day 2: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

The Tour to Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples is one of the most amazing tours in Egypt, which will start after finishing eating breakfast on board your Egypt Nile River Cruise. The boat will head north to the <u>Kom Ombo Temple</u>, The Ptolemaic Temple of God Sobek, and one of the gods of heaven known as Haroeris, who was worshipped in this area, will be our next stop. Your boat will set sail for <u>Edfu</u> and your delectable buffet lunch will be served once everyone has had enough time to explore the temple.

After arriving at Edfu Temple, you will ride a carriage to the ancient Horus Temple before boarding a boat and sailing to Esna while enjoying your afternoon tea. Another excellent dinner will be served on board in the evening. After returning from your tour of Edfu, you will spend the night aboard your Nile Cruise in Esna, where the entertainment will be a very extraordinary Egyptian Galabeya Party.

Day 3: Luxor Sightseeing Tours

Enjoy an enjoyable breakfast as the boat makes its way towards Luxor, then get ready for the West Bank of Luxor Tours, which many people regard as the city's top attraction.

Explore the Valley of the Kings, which is renowned for its rock-cut tombs where numerous New Kingdom pharaohs, such as Ramses the Great and Tutankhamun, were laid to rest. Tutankhamun's tomb discovered completely intact in 1922, stands as a testament to one of the most successful excavations in Egypt's history. Afterward, you'll visit the impressive <u>Temple Hatshepsut</u>, which is a prominent attraction in Luxor.

Conclude your tour by witnessing the ancient Colossi of Memnon, which was built for King Amenhotep III, before enjoying a delightful onboard lunch. The Luxor Temple will be visited after the impressively well-preserved <u>Karnak Temple</u> as part of our ongoing Luxor sightseeing tours. After the incredible East and West Bank Day tour, savor a hearty dinner and spend one more night on the cruise ship.
