Day 1: Embarkation/ Visit Abu Simbel Temples

These wonderful rock temples are considered the second-most famous ancient monuments in Egypt. After the pyramids of Giza.

These three sites will amaze you, and a visit will be an unforgettable experience for the rest of your life.

Once you are back on the cruise ship, you will begin sailing to Wadi Seboua, also known as the Valley of the Lions. A delicious lunch will be served along the way, and afternoon tea will be served shortly afterward.

In the evening, you will have a drink at a small reception, followed by a delicious dinner and an exciting Nubian show. The night is spent on board the boat in Wadi Seboua.

Day 3: Wadi El Seboua Excursion and sailing to Aswan

After your visit to the temple, you will be transferred back to the Prince Abbas Nasser Lake Tour, where you will begin your journey towards Aswan. Your lunch will be served, and you will enjoy afternoon tea. Dinner will be taken on board, and you will spend the night on board in Aswan.
