Itinerary

Day 1: Cairo arrival

At Cairo International Airport, a qualified tour guide will be waiting for you with a sign bearing your name. He will transport you by car to your hotel in Cairo or Giza, where we will assist you with check-in. We'll also go over your schedule for the 6 Days in Cairo and White Desert Camping Christmas Tour with you to make sure all of your pickup timings are accurate.

Get a night's sleep in Cairo.

Day 2: Egyptian Museum, Giza Pyramids, Coptic Cairo, Khan El Khalili

After enjoying your first buffet breakfast at the hotel, head to the Giza Plateau—where your dreams come true—with your own English-speaking tour guide. See the famous King Cheops' Great Giza Pyramid, which was constructed on a squared-off plot of land orientated in an odd cardinality that continues to astound astronomers worldwide with its faultless precision. Along with the Pyramids of Chephren, your guide will show you the smallest royal pyramid in the Necropolis, which was constructed by King Mycerinus later on, you spend some time shooting images in addition to getting the complete explanation you require. In addition to seeing and learning about the Great Sphinx—a massive statue with a human head and a lion's body—you will also visit the Valley Temple of King Chephren, which was constructed in front of the enormous statue, the location of the mummification procedure.

After lunch at one of Cairo's best restaurants, you'll drive to the Islamic district of the city to explore the markets, experience Egyptian culture firsthand, and sample the traditional tea-mint at El Fishawy or Layaly Al-Hussein, two of the city's oldest cafés located in Khan El Khalili. Once more, spending the night in Cairo at the hotel.

After that, go on to the Egyptian Museum, where your guide will provide you with all the necessary information on the artwork, including the objects belonging to the golden pharaoh Tutankhamen, who was found in the Valley of the Kings in 1922.

Enjoy your Coptic Cairo tour, which includes visiting the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon, which was constructed in the first century by Emperor Trajan, and the mysteriously constructed Hanging Church above the fortress's towers. Next, you and your private tour guide will stroll through the streets of Old Cairo to see the church of St. Sergius and the crypt where the holy family resided for three months. The last stop on your tour of Old Cairo is the Ben Ezra Synagogue, which is one of the city's oldest Jewish synagogues.

Day 3: Bahariya Oasis to Cairo

After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, check out and get ready to meet your tour guide, who is accredited by Cairo's Top Tours, to begin your nearly 4-hour journey to the Bahariya Oasis by air-conditioned vehicle. When you arrive, you'll be taken to see the Valley of the Golden Mummies, which was unintentionally discovered to contain hundreds of gold-coated mummies from the Roman era in Egypt when a donkey carriage became caught in a hole.

Following that, you will see the Nobles' Tombs who governed the oasis during the Pharaonic era. Along with the temple of Ein El Meffetla, thought to be the center of the ancient city of Al Qasr, and the so-called temple of Alexander the Great in Bahariya Oasis, which was unfortunately damaged by many natural circumstances that resulted in the partial loss of some of the inscriptions and carvings.

After a delicious lunch at the oasis, you'll be driven to the hotel to check in and have the afternoon to yourself. When you swim in the hotel's hot spring, you may experience the groundwater's minerals.

The experience is worth climbing Black Mountain to see the ruins of the English house at the summit and to get a panoramic view of the entire oasis and its clear blue sky at sunset. Before the sun sets, you will be taken on a walk through the oasis and meet with the locals to learn more about the Oasis traditions and exclusive customs.

Stay the night at the Bahariya Oasis.

Day 4: The Black and White Deserts

Following a delightful breakfast, we will begin the day with a visit to the expansive salt lake and golden sand dunes in Bahariya. Following this, you will proceed on an excursion to view the local fruit fields and palm trees. We will be seeing The Black Desert, an intriguing region of volcanic compositions and black-colored mountains with a large quantity of little black stones, after a delicious lunch. After a brief halt at the Valley of El Haize, proceed to the quartz Crystal Mountain and the Valley of Agabat.

Reaching the White Desert, a sizable area covered with chalk formations sculpted by the nation's yearly springtime sandstorms. These formations produce strangely intriguing shapes, some of which appear to have been intentionally carved.

While your native Bedouin guides prepare your freshly prepared meal, you will have the unique opportunity to witness the uncommon eastern desert fox during your overnight camping trip in the White Desert. You will also be treated to a breathtaking sunset vista.
