Day 1: Cairo arrival and check in

At Cairo International Airport, our representative will be there to welcome you and assist you with the transport. Day 2: Touring the Giza Pyramids, Memphis, and Saqqara

After breakfast, which is made and served at your hotel's main restaurant, you may begin your day travels throughout Cairo. The grandest of all the Egyptian pyramids, the pyramid of King Cheops was constructed by the hands of 100,000 workmen, as historians and archaeologists had predicted, and

our certified tour guide will pick you up to take you on a guided tour of the Great Pyramids in Giza.

The colossal pyramid of King Chephren, constructed about two decades after the Great Pyramids, was constructed with millions of lime stone blocks by the 4th dynasty Pharaoh's son and heir, Mycerinus. You will also discover how the ancient Egyptians built the pyramids.

You may have an optional camel ride around the Giza Pyramids to take some amazing pictures with your Bedouin guide while admiring the picturesque view of the entire necropolis from the high Giza plateau.

You will now descend to see the king's head on a lion's body figure, which represents a guardian to the pyramids behind. The Sphinx's original name is unknown, but it is thought that the Greeks borrowed it from an old name that meant "the living image of a deity," which is likely Shipses-ankh.

The Chephren Valley Temple:

The king constructed a remarkable temple, thought to be the only valley temple still standing at Giza, as part of the second pyramid architectural complex for the mummification of the pharaoh's body.

During your Egypt tours, take in a panoramic view of all the Giza pyramids with us. We'll assist you in taking the most incredible photos. If you'd like, you may visit the Solar Boat Museum, but you'll need to purchase an additional ticket there.

After stopping for a delicious lunch at a neighborhood eatery, continue on to <u>Saqqara Necropolis</u> to explore the renowned <u>Step Pyramid Complex</u>, the Old Kingdom aristocracy's tombs, and take in the breathtaking color of the everyday scenes within. At last, you will have the opportunity to step into either King Teti's or King Unas' pyramid.

The last destination on this day is <u>Memphis City</u>, which served as Egypt's capital for about a century at the time when the pyramids were being built. Memphis City was a major center of culture and religion over the three millennia that ancient Egypt was under Egyptian rule. When you get there, you may see the wonders of the old city, such the massive King Ramses I monument and the Memphis museum's alabaster sphinx.

We will transfer you back to your hotel after enjoying your tour

Overnight in Cairo.

Day 3: Visit Old Cairo and the Egyptian Museum

After enjoying a delectable breakfast at your Cairo hotel, your Egyptologist guide and personal driver will take you to see one of the most significant museums in the world. During the Egyptian Museum tour, you will witness an odd exhibition of ancient Egyptian treasures, including the well-known gold mask of King Tutankhamen.

Next, we'll take you to <u>the Saladin Citadel</u>, which was constructed in the twelfth century to defend Cairo, and <u>the Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali Basha</u>, one of the numerous structures housed within the citadel that belonged to the monarch of Egypt in the first half of the 17th century, who was

of Albanian descent.

After a delicious lunch at a first-rate restaurant, you'll continue your tour of Coptic Cairo by seeing the Hanging Church, the ancient Roman castle known as the castle of Babylon, and the church of Abu Serga, also known as the church of the holy family. One of the oldest synagogues in Egypt and the Middle East, the Synagogue of Ben Ezra, is the destination of our final trip in Coptic Cairo.

During our <u>Cairo Day Tours</u>, we will begin our Islamic Cairo tours, which will allow you to visit <u>Khan El</u> Khalili and see an ancient medieval bazaar.

Your driver will return you to the Cairo hotel after the tour.

Day 4: Travel from Cairo to Sharm El Sheikh

Early in the morning, have breakfast at the hotel and get ready to be driven to <u>Cairo International</u> <u>Airport</u> to continue your <u>Egypt Christmas Tours</u> and board the aircraft to Sharm El Sheikh. Our agent will meet you at the airport in Sharm El Sheikh, take you to the hotel for check-in, and give you some free time in the afternoon and evening.

You will arrive at the highest point after roughly an hour of driving, where you may relax and enjoy a traditional Bedouin herbal tea. Once you ride your bike back to the Quad Bike Center, your airconditioned car will take you back to your hotel. Enjoy your evening as you like.

Day 6: Boat snorkeling excursion in Ras Mohamed

Around eight in the morning, after your daily buffet breakfast is served, you will be driven from your hotel to the sea dock where you will board a boat to sail to <u>Ras Mohamed National Park</u>. There, you will have the opportunity to enjoy a pleasant snorkeling trip in Sharm El Sheikh and learn about the

underwater world beneath the Red Sea, which is home to more than 130 different types of coral reefs and 1000 different species of colorful fish.

Lunch will be given during the excursion, and the boat will stop three times so you may enjoy swimming and snorkeling in the Red Sea. When the day is over, the boat will return you to the beach, where you will be given a ride back to your hotel.
