Day 1: Tours of the Luxor East Bank on Monday

When you arrive at the Luxor Airport or train station, a sign with your name on it will be waiting for you. After that, our tour guide will take you on a delightful Nile River cruise on the Movenpick MS Royal Lily. We'll serve lunch at approximately 13:00.

After a delectable lunch on board, guests will cruise the Nile to Luxor to tour Luxor East Bank Tours, which include the two well-known Luxor temples. Initially, you will be taken by our knowledgeable guide to see the amazing Karnak Temple, which is the biggest in Egypt and the globe, and tour its hypostyle hall, which resembles a forest of enormous pillars. Along with the Karnak Temple, you will also see the Luxor Temple, which was constructed by two of the greatest Egyptian pharaohs, Ramses I and Amenophis III, and joined by an avenue of sphinxes on both sides. After that, you'll head back to the ship for dinner, afternoon tea, and overnight stay on your opulent Nile

Day 2: Tours of the Luxor West Bank on Tuesday

After the breakfast on your Egypt Nile River cruise, start your Luxor day trips to the West Bank of the Nile. Your private driver and Egyptologist guide will accompany you to explore the Valley of the Kings, where 64 of the most well-known Egyptian pharaohs' tombs have so far been found. Of these, Tutankamen's tomb is the only one that has been found intact and contains thousands of gold and silver artifacts that have not been looted in antiquity.

The magnificent temple of Hatshepsut, also known as El Deir El Bahari, the second pharaoh woman of ancient Egypt, is another stop on the West Bank of Luxor tour. It is a remarkable monument made of limestone steps. At the conclusion of your Luxor West Bank Tours, you will also see the Colossi of Memnon, two enormous, monumental statues of Amenhotep III, the only remnants of his funerary temple. Navigate via Esna to Edfu. Lunch on board the cruise ship, followed by afternoon tea in free time. In Edfu, enjoy dinner and spend the night on your Nile cruise ship.

Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner Meals

Day 3: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples on Wednesday

Savor a delicious breakfast while on your Egypt Nile River Cruise, and then see the Temple of Edfu, which honors the legendary falcon deity Horus. Among all the Egyptian temples, the Edfu Temple is the best

preserved; construction was finished about 200 years ago. See the Kom Ombo Temple, which honors the gods Sobek and Haeroris. Have lunch and afternoon tea on board before dinner, then spend the night in Aswan on the cruise liner.

Meals: breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 4: Aswan Nile Cruise Tours on Thursday

A fantastic breakfast will be provided while cruising the Nile, and as you prepare for your Aswan day trips, you may see the High Dam, which was constructed during the reign of Egypt's previous president, Nasser. The building of the high dam in Egypt submerged the Philae Temple on Agilika Island near Aswan, and it was relocated stone by stone to a new island. Visit the Unfinished Obelisk of Queen Hatshepsut, which is located in the granite quarries that formerly produced the stones for the majority of the most notable structures. Take a felucca sailing cruise around Kitchener Island on the Nile. Lunch and afternoon tea on board the cruise ship. After supper, spend the night on the Nile. Enjoy dinner and spend the night aboard the Nile cruise ship in Aswan.

Day 5: Disembarkation on Friday

After breakfast, disembark from your Nile Cruise and be driven by Cairo Top Tours to your chosen drop-off spot.
