Itinerary

Day 1: Tours of the Luxor East Bank on Monday

When you arrive at the airport or train station, we will be there to welcome you. During the Christmas season, we will take you to board your MS Mayfair Nile Cruise, where you will have lunch and begin your Luxor day tours, which will include visits to Luxor Temple and Karnak Temple on the Luxor East Bank. After enjoying a leisurely lunch on board the cruise, you will spend the night in Luxor.

Day 2: Tours of the Luxor West Bank on Tuesday

We shall explore more of Luxor's attractions today, this time on the western side of the Nile. Following a hearty breakfast on board, we will leave to take advantage of Luxor West Bank Tours, which include a visit to the well-known Valley of the Kings, home to numerous ancient Pharaohs' tombs (including those of Seti I, Tutankhamen, and Thutmose III), as well as information about mummification practices in prehistoric Egypt. We will also learn about the Queen Hatshepsut Mortuary Temple, which is one of the most fascinating sites to visit and was constructed to honor the god Amon-Ra. And lastly, we must not overlook King Amenhotep III's representation, the Colossi of Memnon. These enormous statues, which formerly oversaw the funerary complex of Amenhotep III.

Day 3: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples on Wednesday

We shall continue with our premium MS Mayfair Nile Cruise Tours of Egypt. We will eat a delicious breakfast early in the morning and get ready for yet another amazing day filled with amazing visits. The Temple of Edfu, which honors the god Horus, is the second-largest temple in all of Egypt after the Karnak Temple and is among the best preserved. dated to the Hellenistic era, approximately 2200 years ago, and dedicated to the falcon god Horus.

After lunch, we will head back to the cruise ship and prepare for yet another amazing excursion to the Temple of Kom Ombo, which is dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek.

With a distinct proportional design, this temple honors two local deities: old Horus, the falcon god, and Sobek, the crocodile god. The temple is exquisitely gorgeous.

We will sail to Aswan after getting back on board, where we will have dinner and take part in the cruise's activities.

Day 4: Aswan Nile Cruise Tours on Thursday

Set up for the Aswan day trips after breakfast on the boat. We may find the massive dam that gives this remarkable city its fame, the Aswan High Dam, a contemporary megastructure, here. Next, we shall witness the Unfinished Obelisk, which was cut from a single rock and would have been the largest in the world. After it has been moved, we shall eventually be astounded by the magnificent Temple of Philae, which is situated on an island.

We will head back to our ship for lunch and some relaxation once our excursions in Aswan come to an end. After enjoying the onboard activities, we'll have dinner in the cruise ship's restaurant.
