Day 1: Get to Luxor; check in; depart with East Bank Tours

Greetings from Luxor, Egypt

You will be greeted upon your arrival at the Luxor International Airport or Railway station by an accredited tour guide from Cairo Top Tours. After a seamless check-in, your personal driver will take you to board your Egypt Nile River Cruise, where you will spend five days traveling from Luxor to Cairo on the MS Movenpick Royal Lily Nile.

In addition to reviewing your Egypt Christmas vacation schedule, our licensed tour manager will accompany you on your Nile cruise and provide you with comprehensive knowledge about Egypt's history and culture, including an explanation of all the locations and temples the ship will visit. The first stop on your Luxor day trip will be the well-known Luxor Temple, referred to as "ipet rsyt," or "the southern sanctuary," which is regarded as the greatest and most important ancient Egyptian sacred site. Proceed to explore the Karnak Temple, which is devoted to the gods Amun Re, Mut, and Khonsu and is said to be a complex of numerous temples, kiosks, and pylons constructed by numerous pharaohs over the course of many eras. Day 2: Cruise to Esna - Luxor West Bank Excursions

Day 3: Arrival from Luxor to Aswan and Edfu Temple - Kom Ombo Temple

Constructed during the Ptolemaic period, this temple is devoted to God Horus, the protector of kingship and the god of heaven. Horus is a well-known deity who frequently appears in ancient Egyptian mythology and legends. He is the son of Osiris and the goddess Isis. After a hearty lunch, your personal guide will return you to the cruise ship. Before the Nile cruise departs for Kom Ombo, you will meet your guide in the foyer and begin your stroll to the magnificent Temple of Kom Ombo, devoted to the falcon-headed god Horaeris and the crocodile god Sobek. In the evening, take in some entertainment after a delicious dinner in the main restaurant.

Day 4: Cruise Tours Along the Nile

After enjoying a delicious breakfast on the ship as you travel to Aswan, you will see the High Dam, which was constructed there to regulate Egypt's flooding and generate electricity by spanning the Nile. After that, take a motorboat excursion to Phiale, which has captivated the interest of countless tourists to Egypt since ancient times, and view the Unfinished Obelisk. Known as the "Pearl of Egypt," it was renowned for its exquisite beauty. Proceed with your Aswan day trips to view the Philae Temple, constructed in honor of the goddess Isis. Spend the evening in Aswan taking in a folkloric entertainment and dinner.
