Day 1: Greetings from Cairo, Egypt

At the Cairo International Airport, look for our Cairo Top Tours representative holding a sign with your name and Cairo Top Tours. After a seamless journey to your Cairo hotel, the specifics of your 11-day Egypt Christmas Tour Package will be discussed with you to make sure you get the most out of all of your excursions while in Egypt.

Day 2: Tours of Cairo and the Pyramids

After breakfast, start your Cairo day trip and enjoy the Giza Pyramids, which include the Great Pyramid of Cheops, the two pyramids of Chephren and Mycerinus, and the Great Sphinx, a representation of strength and knowledge with the head of a lion and the body of a monarch. After enjoying a delicious local lunch at one of the top-notch restaurants, continue your tour of Coptic Cairo by visiting the Museum of Egyptian Antiquities, which houses an enormous collection of ancient artifacts, and Old Cairo churches, such as the Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin Mary, the Synagogue of Ben Ezra, and the Church of Saint Sergius and Bachus. once your trip to Cairo is over, you will be escorted back to your Cairo hotel where you will spend the night.

Day 3: Tour of the White Desert

After a delicious breakfast, you will be taken to explore the fascinating White Desert, which is close to the Black Desert. Not only do curious people come to the desolate and completely dead desert, but professional photographers go as well. You can produce distinctive shots at specific times of the day because the dance of shadows creates an even more breathtaking scene. The most common way to enter the Black Desert is by private vehicle (rental or excursion), as the minibuses that travel from the capital to the area don't have a designated stop, which makes sense. The Bahariya Oasis' central village, Valley of El Haize, is located approximately 50 km south of Bawiti, including a visit to the stunning Agabat Valley and the enthralling crystal at Crystal Mountain. The chance to tent in the White Desert is fantastic. Savor your sumptuous dinner after taking in the stunning sunset.

Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner Meals

Day 4: Tour of Bahariya Oasis

After breakfast, you will continue your tour of the White Desert by taking in the amazing views of the naturally occurring limestone formations of rabbits, mushrooms, and other shapes. You will also come across hot springs with skin-beneficial natural elements.

Return to Bahariya Oasis, after which your tour guide will take you to check into your hotel in Cairo and spend the night.

Day 5: Sightseeing Tours in Aswan - Cairo to Aswan

Following breakfast at your Cairo hotel, you will be driven to Cairo International Airport to board your flight to Aswan. Once in Aswan, you will be greeted by a representative from Cairo Top Tours to commence your Aswan tours. First, you will visit the Aswan High Dam, which was built in 1960 to shield Egypt from the yearly floods. Next, you will visit the Philae Temple, which is known for its unusual stones and engravings that have survived for thousands of years. After that, you will be driven to your Aswan hotel where you will check in and spend the night.

Day 6: Spend the night in Luxor at Edfu Temple

After breakfast and check-out, proceed to the magnificent Edfu Temple, which honors the falcon. After lunch, you will have time to explore the splendor of the god Horus, son of Osiris and guardian of royalty, before being taken to your Luxor hotel.

Day 7: Tours of Luxor East Bank

After enjoying a delicious breakfast to start the day, head to the 1975 opening of the Luxor Museum. Your next stop will be Luxor Temple, a massive ancient Egyptian temple built on the east bank of the Nile by King Amenhotep III in the New Kingdom and completed by the renowned Pharaoh Ramses II during the 19th Dynasty. The structure is a two-story structure that represents grave goods from the tomb of the golden pharaoh Tutankhamen of the 18th dynasty. A number of statues dating back to the New Kingdom were discovered hidden in the Luxor statue cache in Luxor Temple.

Day 8: Tours of Luxor's West Bank

This is a unique day when you can extend your Luxor Tours by touring the main attractions during the Luxor West Bank Tours. The most famous tomb is that of the young king Tutankhamen. The Valley of the Kings is where the Kings and Pharaohs of the New Kingdom built their tombs to protect them from tomb robbers and because they believed they would be resurrected in the afterlife, just as the sun dies every day in the West and is born again in the East, then pay a visit to Hatshepsut's Temple, named after the first female pharaoh whose monumental temple still stands today. Keep admiring the enormous statues known as the Colossi of Memnon, which depict Amenhotep III reclining in a position of majesty.

After that, you'll be driven to an overnight hotel in Hurghada.
