Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival day

Our Cairo Top Tours tour leader will meet you at the airport and drive you to your Cairo hotel. The guide will assist you with a seamless check-in process and provide you an updated schedule so you can make the most of your Christmas vacation to Hurghada, The Nile, and Cairo. Spend the first night preparing for an early morning trip to the Egyptian Pyramids.

Day 2: Tour of the Sphinx and Pyramids

After breakfast, start your Cairo Day Tour with your tour guide at the hotel lobby. You'll go to the Giza Pyramids and see the Sphinx, which is thought to resemble King Chephren, the owner of the middle pyramid. Your visit to the Pyramids region is sure to increase your heart rate since you will be able to see the greatest of the world's seven wonders, created centuries ago to help people remember the names of the great Pharaohs, like Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus.

Before seeing the Valley Temple, which was constructed for the king's mummification rites and also served as the inspiration for the Great Sphinx, which stands as a testament to the might and wisdom of the ancient Egyptian pharaohs, you will have the chance to take a camel ride through the Giza Pyramids (an optional activity).

Savor a delicious lunch at a chic city restaurant before spending the night in your Cairo hotel.

Meals: Lunch and Breakfast

Day 3: Travel to Alexandria

After breakfast, start your Alexandria Tour from Cairo. After a two-hour trip in a luxurious air-conditioned car, you will be taken to Alexandria City on the Mediterranean Sea. Alexandria City was constructed by Alexander the Great in the Greco-Roman era and was once regarded as the most beautiful city on earth. Visit the modern Bibliotheca of Alexandria, enjoy delectable fresh seafood at a very high-quality restaurant, and see the Greco-Roman catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, the ruins of the Roman temple complex, Pompey's pillar, and the Citadel of Qaitbay where the famous lighthouse Pharos (one of the seven man-made wonders of the world) used to be standing.

After that, head to your hotel in Alexandria for overnight.

Day 4: Egyptian Museum- Train to Aswan

After breakfast, you will head back to Cairo in the early morning to see the fantastic Egyptian Museum downtown, which houses the world's largest and most distinctive collection of Egyptian antiquities as well as the only royal treasure discovered in good condition: the golden pharaoh Tutankhamen's treasures. Delicious lunch at a reputable neighborhood eatery before making your way to the train station to board the sleeping train that will take you to Aswan, where you will spend the night in your compartment.

Day 5: Aswan Excursions - Arrive Aswan

On Aswan Day Tours, we will get the chance to see some of the most remarkable locations in Aswan. See the Aswan High Dam, constructed in 1960 to protect Egypt from the yearly floods, and then pay a visit to the Philae Temple, which is home to incredible stones and inscriptions that have been preserved for thousands of years and tell us about the strength and sophistication of our ancestors. Following that, you'll be driven to your Aswan hotel so you may spend the night and check in.

Day 6: Temples of Abu Simbel

Visit the Abu Simbel Temples after breakfast for a unique experience. During the reign of Pharaoh Ramses II in the 19th century B.C., the twin temples were cut out of the mountainside. These are memorials to the pharaoh and his queen Nefertari, and their enormous outside rock relief statues have become famous as a reminder of his triumph at the Battle of Kadesh. Back at your Aswan hotel for the night.

Meals: Lunch and Breakfast

Day 7: Luxor Temple - Aswan to Luxor

After breakfast, continue with your Egypt Christmas Tours from your hotel. You will be driven to Luxor by our representative, where you will see the magnificent Temple of Luxor, which was finished by Ramses II in the 19th Dynasty (New Kingdom) after it was begun by King Amenhotep III. Back at your Aswan hotel for the night.

Day 8: Land Transfer to Hurghada from Karnak Temple and Luxor West Bank

Enjoy your breakfast and get ready for your Luxor Day Tours journey to the largest temple in the world, the Karnak Temples, which are devoted to the god Amun, his wife Mut, and their son Khonsu. This is the finest illustration of Egyptian excellence in history. It was built by numerous Kings between the start of the Middle Kingdom and the Greco-Roman Kingdom. In addition, you will see the West Bank of the Nile monuments, the Hatshepsut Temple in Deir Al-Bahari, the Valley of the Kings, and the Colossi of Memnon. After traveling by land to Hurghada for around three hours, you will spend the night in a Hurghada hotel.

Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner Meals

Day 9: Hurghada Submarine Adventure

After breakfast, take a fantastic two-hour underwater tour of the Red Sea aboard the Sindbad Submarine. This is the only submarine in the Middle East that can accommodate 44 passengers and has a crew of two captains. Enjoy viewing a variety of marine species, stunning coral reefs, and colorful fish. It descends 22 meters below sea level, where a variety of marine life is visible. Becoming a certified scuba diver is not required. You will be returned to the Hurghada hotel after you are done.

Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner Meals

Day 10: Hurghada's Free Day

In Hurghada, you'll have the day to yourself! Savor your morning meal at the hotel, and then make the most of your free time by exploring Hurghada or going on one of the many tours and excursions available. Spend the night at Hurghada.

Day11: Returning to Cairo from Hurghada

Following breakfast, you will be transferred to Hurghada Airport to catch your aircraft to Cairo International Airport, where you can spend the remainder of the day on a variety of Cairo Day Tours. Alternatively, you can just eat at a floating restaurant while taking in a distinctive performance of entertainment.
